2018 Pool Season

Make Sure You Have Your Amenity Card!

Based on resident feedback, the Riverstone HOA is excited to announce a change for the 2018 pool season. This year's pool season will kick off in May at The Waterpark at Riverstone!

The Waterpark will be open every weekend in May, with Saturday hours from 10:00am–9:00pm and Sunday hours from 11:00am–8:00pm. (The complete 2018 Pool Guide and Schedule will be included in next month's newsletter.)

With pool season quickly approaching, it's time to find your Riverstone amenity cards now! It is not necessary to 'renew' your amenity cards. As long as you are a Riverstone resident in good standing, your card will remain active allowing you access to all three pools, the fitness center, tennis courts, and park restrooms.

All residents age five and older are required to show their Riverstone amenity card when visiting one of Riverstone's pools. Residents will not be permitted entry without their Riverstone amenity card.

As a reminder, children under age 14 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian during the entirety of pool visits. Children age 14-17 are permitted entry to the pool without a parent/guardian as long as they have a 'resident minor' amenity card. If you have a child who has recently turned 14, please bring them to the HOA office to obtain a new card.

Guests of Riverstone residents may visit the pools provided the resident has a valid Riverstone amenity card, valid Riverstone guest card, and remains in attendance during the guest's entire

visit. Up to five (5) guests may be permitted entry on a Riverstone guest card per family visit.

Lost/misplaced amenity cards can be replaced for a fee of \$15 per adult/resident minor/guest card, and \$7 per child card. (The HOA office will accept credit card and/or check for replacement cards.)

New residents can obtain Riverstone amenity cards by visiting the HOA office. New residents must provide proof of residency and a photo ID. Proof of residency may be in the form of a current utility bill or copy of the settlement statement. Residents will also need to complete/sign the Amenity Card Access Form, and each family member will need to have a picture taken for use on the card. Forms are available at the HOA office or online at www.rshoa.org > Resource Center > Forms.

Have questions about your family's amenity cards? Please contact the HOA office at 281.778.2222 or email customer@rshoa.org. Normal HOA office hours are M-F 9:00am–5:00pm, with extended hours on Wednesday evenings until 7:00pm. To help accommodate residents' busy schedules, HOA staff will be available to print amenity cards from 9:30am–12:30pm the following Saturdays in May: May 5th, May 12th, and May 26th.

Riverstone's Wetlands

An Important Part of the Community



Did you ever wonder why there are plants growing in some of the lakes around Riverstone? There are approximately 25 acres of man-made wetland areas within the community. When Riverstone was beginning development, impacts to special aquatic sites, e.g. existing wetlands, were unavoidable. As a result, Riverstone was required to obtain a permit from the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) by stating impacts and including mitigation of resources for the aquatic ecosystem in this area.

New wetland areas were created within the lakes that were constructed throughout the Riverstone community. These new wetland plants, while fulfilling the mitigation component of the USACE permit, also provide valuable ecosystem services to the area. These services include, but are not limited to: fish habitat, food for wildlife, water quality enhancement, biodiversity, and nutrient cycling.

Maintenance activity within the wetlands is limited in order to comply with federal laws. Furthermore, since Riverstone's wetlands are intended to be natural systems, they are not manicured to the same aesthetic standards as a resident's lawn or some of the other common areas. While some residents may consider the wetlands unsightly during portions of the year, these areas are providing valuable function to the environment.

Tennis Court Etiquette

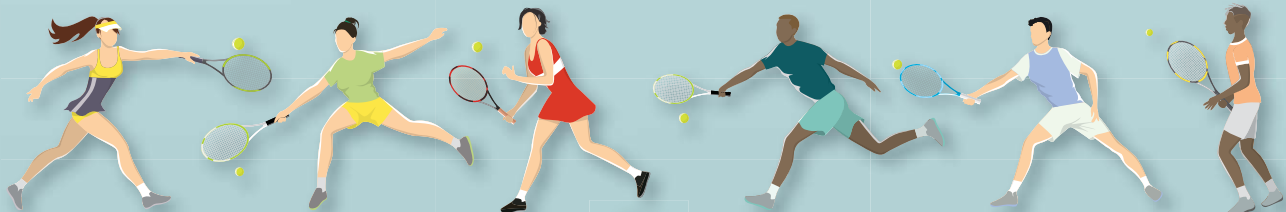
- 🏆 Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- 🏆 Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- 🏆 When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court. Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.

Did You Know?

That you can lose weight by just playing tennis. An hour of singles play can burn anywhere between 580-870 calories.

- 🏆 Riverstone's Tennis rules and regulations rule #11 prohibits the booking of back to back times on the same court. Second booking will be unreserved by the system administrator.
- 🏆 Court #6 at The Club at Riverstone and court #1 at Riverstone Blvd are designated as walk on courts.
- 🏆 Only authorized professionals are allowed to teach at both Riverstone's locations.

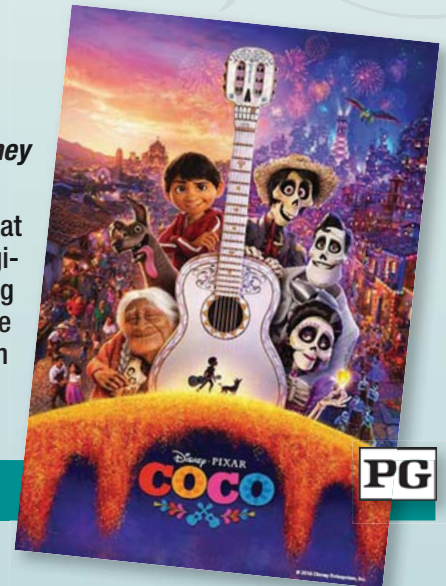

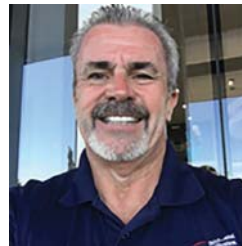

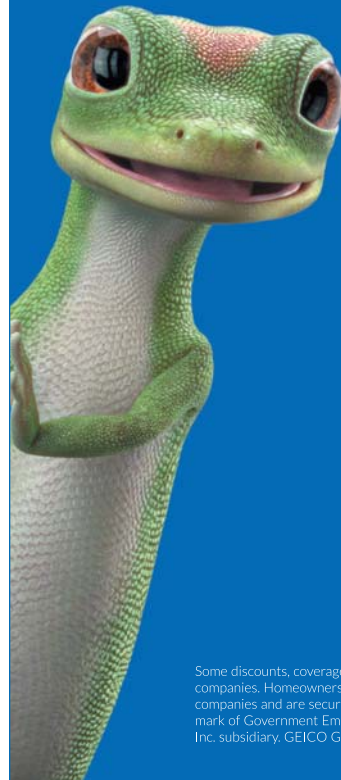
