Your Reserve Dollars at Work!

Have you noticed the beautiful landscape enhancements around the community? This is just one example of your reserve dollars at work!

Reserve funding is an essential and responsible part of the Association's fiscal planning. Reserve Funding allows the Association to make necessary repairs to its assets which include swimming pools, buildings, tennis courts, parks & playgrounds, fences, irrigation system, monument signs, etc.

Exterior Inspection of Your Home

A recent survey of HOA members conducted by Public Opinion Strategies for CAI revealed that the **number one** reason survey respondents chose to live in a neighborhood with a community association is that they wanted to live in a **clean, attractive neighborhood**. Residents depend on HOA Boards and managers to maintain the neighborhood amenities and remind neighbors to keep individually owned areas clean, as well. As residents begin to think about Spring Cleaning, here is some advice to help avoid some common pitfalls:

- **Power Washing**—While very efficient and effective for cleaning some surfaces around a home or neighborhood, power washing, which uses high pressure, high volume, hot water to clean, represents a big risk for homeowners if they are not well-informed. Power washing works great for concrete and masonry, but if used on the house can ultimately damage siding, blast out mortar, destroy paint, break windows and door seals, and does nothing to inhibit the future growth of mildew.
- **Soft Washing**—Soft washing differs from power washing in that it uses low pressure (about that of a garden hose), high volume, surfactant with cleaning agents and fungicides to safely kill and lift organic material from almost any surface. This low, or “soft,” pressure can be used to clean siding, painted metal, shingles, wood, EIFS,

stucco, brick, and more. And, because it completely kills the organisms on the surface, often this method can deliver a clean-looking surface for over 18 months.

For the DIYers out there, there are several over the counter products consumers can buy from big box home improvement stores that can be applied using a garden hose that promise to remove algae stains from vinyl siding, and they do work effectively for minor stains. In most instances, a better result may be achieved if a professional, insured, certified power washing company that understands both power and soft wash methods is hired. Things to look for in a qualified cleaning contractor are positive reviews and references, minimum of \$1,000,000 liability insurance, membership in professional organizations like PWNA (Power Washers of North America) or PWN (Professional Washing Network), a certification process for cleaning technicians, and years of experience.

Don't let unsightly stains build up on your home this Spring. Not only do the stains diminish the appearance of your home, but those stains may be damaging your paint and shingles as well.

New Retail *More Convenience*

A number of commercial construction projects are underway that will add a slate of new retail and other conveniences for Riverstone residents.

Riverstone's first on-site grocery store is currently under construction and scheduled to open later this year. The 100,000-square-foot Kroger located at University Boulevard and LJ Parkway will feature an in-house Starbucks and a specialty cheese shop as well as fresh meats, breads, seafood and other staples. In addition, the new store will offer ClickList, an online grocery ordering service allowing customers to shop online for items and then pick it up later at the store. Kroger associates will even bring the order to the car and load it.

The Kroger will anchor The Village at Riverstone, a 165,000-square-foot shopping center that will include addi-

tional retail, restaurants and services. The center is already 90 percent filled and a tenant list will be released once construction nears completion. Learn more at www.regencycenters.com

Across the street, the new Pengu Swim School will soon have young Riverstone residents splashing around. A new Montessori daycare also has just begun construction. A future shopping center also is in the works at Riverstone and Cross Lakes Boulevards.

As the construction dust settles, Riverstone residents will discover even more convenient shopping options complementing the existing retail found around Riverstone along Highway 6.

Tennis Court Etiquette

- 🏆 Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- 🏆 Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- 🏆 When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court. Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.

Tennis Court Reminders

- 🏆 Riverstone's Tennis rules and regulations rule #11 prohibits the booking of back to back times on the same court. Second booking will be unreserved by the system administrator.
- 🏆 Court #6 at The Club at Riverstone and court #1 at Riverstone Blvd are designated as walk on courts.
- 🏆 Only authorized professionals are allowed to teach at both Riverstone's locations.
