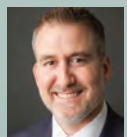

New Web Portal



We have a very exciting new announcement! Riverstone HOA has recently launched a new web portal that will provide you convenient, real time, 24-hour access to your account. Once logged into the new portal, all homeowners will be able to view and update your homeowner information, view account information and make payments, view compliance violations and architectural requests, and more! You can access the portal from our website at www.rshoa.org and clicking the Resident Account Portal tab on the left side of your screen.

When you are logging into the web portal for the first time, you will need to select the "Create login" link. Within the next screen, you must enter your account number and email address of your choice. The provided email address will be linked to your login record. If you do not have your Account Number, please contact us at customer@rshoa.org. It will also be printed on the 2019 Assessment statement that will be mailed later this month.

If you are one of multiple owners associated with the provided account number, you are required to select your name from the list provided. If a match is found, you will be sent an email with a link to complete your new account process. The email link will allow you to create a username and password (usernames must be unique). Once saved, you will be able to login into the web portal.

Riverstone HOA Reminders

We understand that the season of giving and gifts is quickly approaching! Adults and children alike may be receiving new gifts and fun additions for the holiday season. As a reminder, please note that residents should submit an ARC Modification Application for basketball goals, playsets, and other items related to the outside of the property. Modification submittals are reviewed by the Architectural Review Committee the first Wednesday of each month. Residents can download the ARC Modification Application on the residential website and email the application to ARCModification@rshoa.org.

The holidays can be a joyous time of family gatherings and cheer. From wreaths, tinsel, and colorful lights to Frosty the

Snowman and Santa's reindeer, decorations are a fun and beautiful way to celebrate the season. While the Association enjoys seeing the holiday spirit being displayed as much as anyone else, we would like to send a friendly reminder to all residents to adhere to the deed restrictions when decorating the exterior of your homes. Per the deed restrictions: "Customary seasonal decorations for national holidays are permitted for a maximum of twelve (12) days or thirty (30) days, in the case of Christmas, subject to the right of the Residential ARC to specify a maximum size and other guidelines for decorations". ALL holiday décor must be removed on or before January 25th.

On Election Day eligible voters may cast a ballot at any voting location. Holiday Trash/Recycling Schedule

Both Missouri City and Sugar Land addresses will receive their normal service (trash or recycling collection) through the Thanksgiving weekend. Missouri City residents serviced by WCA will have garbage pickup on Thursday, November 22nd as scheduled and Sugar Land addresses (and residents in Stonebrook) serviced by Best Trash will have garbage pickup on Friday, November 23rd as scheduled.

Residents have the ability to have a box of locally sourced, sustainably grown produce delivered to them for pick up right at The Club at Riverstone. We have partnered with LOAM Agronomics to bring you fresh food from their 288-acre farm located here in Fort Bend. This is accomplished through the Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) program.

A CSA Membership offers many advantages to you and to the community. Eating locally supports community farmers and provides members with produce grown without harmful pesticides. Best of all, fruits and vegetables don't spend days being transported by trucks. All produce can be on your dinner table within 48 hours of harvest.

You can choose the membership or "share" in the LOAM Agronomics' CSA that works best for you. Each week costs

\$30, with recurring weekly payments. Boxes can be picked up at The Club at Riverstone every Wednesday from 3:00pm to 7:00pm. Each box contains 8-10 seasonal varieties of nutritious, delicious produce. You will also receive a members-only newsletter telling you what's in your box, current events at the farm, storage techniques, recipes curated by local chefs and invites to member events on the farm.

If you are going out of town on vacation or cannot pick up your box, you can simply login to your account and put your share on hold. It is very flexible and user friendly. Why register? Not only are you providing your family with a nutrient rich, delicious box of produce, but you are also supporting the growing local food.

Constable Corner

On behalf of Constable Trevor Nehls, the Fort Bend County Precinct 4 Constable's Office wants you to be safe as we prepare for the holidays. As the shopping and holiday outings begin, we want you to be safe and have provided some safety tips to help you get through the holidays.

Here are some things to think about when shopping:

- When parking your vehicle to go shopping, remember where you parked. Always park in a well-lit and well-traveled area. Do not park in a remote dark area.
- Do not open your car door to anyone in a parking lot or garage. If you believe you are in danger, call 911 immediately.
- Lock your vehicle and put your windows up while you are driving or even just sitting in vehicle.
- Don't talk on a cell phone when walking to and from your vehicle. Keep your full attention on your surroundings.
- If you are ready to leave the shopping area and feel uneasy about entering the parking lot or garage by yourself, stay inside of the location you are at and ask for a security escort.
- Have your keys in hand when approaching your vehicle. You will be ready to unlock the door and will not be delayed by fumbling and looking for your keys.
- Don't electronically unlock your vehicle until you are within door opening distance. This helps to stop someone from getting into the car and waiting to strike when you least expect it.

- When you return to your vehicle, scan the interior of your car to be sure no one is hiding inside. Check to see if you are being followed. If you believe you are being followed, set off your panic alarm of your vehicle and/or yell for help.
- If you believe you are being followed in your vehicle, drive to your nearest police station and/or call 911 and follow instructions provided by dispatch.
- When storing items purchased at the stores, place them out of sight. The best place is in a locked trunk.
- Do not leave your purse, wallet, or cellular telephone in plain view. (Vehicle/Unattended shopping basket)
- If you go to an automatic teller machine for cash, check for people around and make sure it is well lit and in a safe location.
- Carry only the credit cards you need and avoid carrying large amounts of cash.

When observing any suspicious or criminal activities please call the Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office for assistance. For emergencies call 911. For non-emergency situations please call 281.341.4665.

Tennis Court Reminders

- 🏸 Riverstone's Tennis rules and regulations rule #11 prohibits the booking of back to back times on the same court. Second booking will be unreserved by the system administrator.
- 🏸 Court #6 at The Club at Riverstone and court #1 at Riverstone Blvd are designated as walk on courts.
- 🏸 Only authorized professionals are allowed to teach at both Riverstone's locations.

Tennis Court Etiquette

- 🏸 Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- 🏸 Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- 🏸 When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court. Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.
- 🏸 When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.
