HOA CORNER

Notes from the Compliance Department

Pet owners are reminded that dogs should be on a leash at all times when out walking within the community. Additionally, residents are asked to be respectful of their neighbors when walking their dogs and to pick up after them. Nothing "stinks" worse than stepping in a surprise in your yard or on the sidewalk.

A Reminder about pets: Per the Riverstone Deed Restrictions, no animals, livestock, or poultry of any kind may be raised, bred, kept, or permitted on any Lot, with the exception of a maximum of three (3) dogs, cats or other usual and common household pets (excluding in such maximum number, fish and birds); provided, however, those pets which are permitted to roam free, or which in the sole discretion of the Board, endanger health, make objectionable noise, or constitute a nuisance or Inconvenience to the Owners or Occupants within the Properties may be removed by the Board. No pets shall be kept, bred or maintained for any commercial purpose. Dogs which are household pets shall at all times whenever they are outside a Single-Family Residence be on a leash or



otherwise confined in a manner acceptable to the Board. Without prejudice to the Board's right to remove any such household pet, the owner of a pet that has caused damage to property shall be responsible for compensating the owner of the damaged property, but the Association shall have no obligation to enforce such obligation. Animal control authorities shall be permitted to enter the Properties to patrol and remove pets. Pets shall be registered, licensed and inoculated as required by law.

Mulch in Landscaping Beds



As the promise of warm weather nears, many residents are anxious to freshen up their landscaping beds. While it still might be too early to cut back dead plant material, replacing faded mulch with new mulch is an easy way to quickly improve the appearance of landscaping beds. Not only is new mulch aesthetically pleasing, but it also serves a practical purpose: Mulch helps insulate plant roots from extreme temperatures, helps prevent the growth of weeds, and helps retain water for plant use.

Please note that per the Riverstone Residential Design Standards, RED MULCH is prohibited. The standards can always be viewed on our website at www.rshoa.org, in the Resource Center, under Governing Documents. By Any Other Name

“Community association” is a generic term that encompasses many names used around the world to describe common-interest housing. A few examples include:

- Common-interest community (CIC) is used by the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws.
- Common-interest realty association (CIRA) is the term preferred by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants.
- Common-interest development (CID) is used by the California Department of Real Estate.
- Condominium association refers to units like apartments, townhouses or other private units that are part of a single structure or group of structures.
- Homeowners association (HOA) is often synonymous with “common-interest community” and usually describes a community of single-family homes.
- Property owners association (POA) can refer to a residential community or a group of offices or other non-residential property.
- Strata title is a term used in Australia, New Zealand, and British Columbia that describes individually owning part of a property, such as an apartment, and sharing ownership in the property’s common or public areas.
- In France and some parts of Quebec, condominiums are called copropriété divisée (divided co-property).
- The traditional term in Spanish-speaking countries for a common-interest community is propiedad horizontal.
- Condominio is the term used in Italy.

Regardless of the name, most community associations in the U.S. are incorporated and subject to state statutes that govern nonprofit corporations. Remember, membership in an association is not voluntary; you become a member when you purchase a home in the community.

Extra! Extra! Read All About It!

While many residents enjoy receiving local newspapers, uncollected papers can become both a security risk and an eye-sore. Papers which do not get picked up in a timely manner make a residence appear uninhabited; making it a potential target for thieves. Here’s how you can help:

- Collect newspapers from the front of your home the same day they are delivered

DON'T FORGET YOUR RESERVATION!

Don't Forget! You need an Amenity Pass reservation on the Riverstone app, as well as your Amenity Card to use the Fitness Center. Download the Riverstone App on your Android or Apple phones to get started. Here are some additional reminders about temporary policies in place:

- All residents entering the facility are required to wear masks.
- Residents are required to sanitize any equipment brought from home before entering the building and again prior to leaving the facility.
- Residents must wash or sanitize hands upon entering the facility.
- Guests will not be permitted at this time.

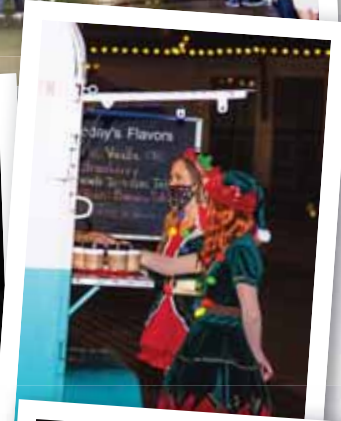

Tennis Court Etiquette

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.

Unauthorized Tennis Lessons

Recently there has been an increase of tennis lessons at Riverstone by unauthorized tennis pros. Please keep in mind that HOA rules prohibits the teaching of tennis lessons by unauthorized persons.

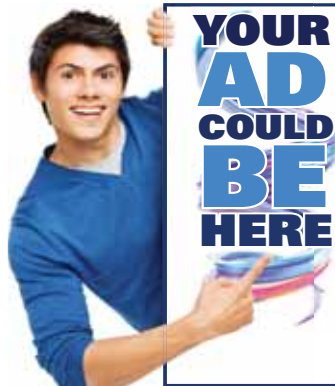

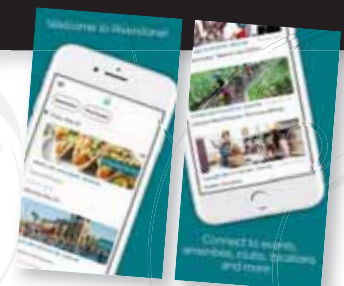
