NEW HOMEOWNERS NEEDING AMENITY CARDS

Welcome to Riverstone! To have amenity cards made for you, please email us the following:

1. Completed amenity card form (found at www.riverstone.com)
2. Deed or closing disclosure

3. Individual headshot pictures of each resident over the age of 5. Please label each photo with their name and date of birth.

4. Proof of identification (State ID, Driver's License, passport, etc) for all residents over the age of 18.

5. Anyone over the age of 18 whose name is not listed on the deed will need to provide additional proof of residence. Examples of acceptable Proof of Residency may include car insurance, utility bill, cell phone bill, etc. and must include the resident's name and current home address.

Each account will receive up to 3 adult amenity cards and at no charge. Each additional adult amenity card after the first 3 cards is \$15.00.

REPLACING A LOST AMENITY CARD

The replacement of lost Amenity Cards is available for \$15 each.

If you need a replacement Amenity Card, please complete the credit card form found on our website (www.riverstone.com) and email it to us at customercare@riverstone.com. Please also include your home address and a headshot picture labeled with your name and date of birth.

- Lost amenity cards may be replaced for \$15 each. Credit Card, Check, Money Order or Cashier's Checks ONLY. No cash will be accepted.

Crepe Myrtles

Crepe Myrtles are a common and beautiful sight in landscapes across Texas. Unfortunately, the practice known as "Crepe Murder" is also a common sore-eyes sight seen this time of year. While winter months are typically a good time to prune trees, crepe murder is an incorrect pruning practice that removes the entire top of the tree each year, also known as a topping.

It's a common myth that this practice is needed to create brilliant blooms or reduce the height of the tree. In reality, crepe murder promotes the vigorous growth of many weakly attached shoots from each cut. Done year after year, crepe murder can lead to disfiguration and decline of the tree.

So, how can we stop and prevent this practice?

First, when planting crepe myrtles, select the right variety for the space. Look up the mature height of your selection before planting to ensure it won't outgrow the space.



Next, prune to maintain the natural form of the tree. Less is typically more here. Focus on removing dead, dying, broken, diseased, or rubbing branches and suckers that grow from the base of the tree.

Finally, help spread the word that crepe murder should be stopped, and together, maybe we can bring this crime to an end.

"We took over the Eye Level Sugar Land East franchise in 2019," Rehmat said. "Since then, we have welcomed students from all across the Missouri City/Sugar Land area and have built relationships with the various educational institutions in the community to foster a learning environment that is tailored to each of our student's needs."

Recently, the Mehdis moved the center to Riverstone since the majority of their students come from the area.

Reema said that individualized learning is crucial for children, who can fall behind if their educational needs are not met.

"Those who struggle to grasp fundamental concepts are at risk of falling behind, considering that the curriculum relies on a solid understanding of these basics," she said.



By accommodating diverse learning profiles, the center can address learning disabilities and special needs, fostering confidence and self-esteem.

Students are assessed on their current grasp of key concepts. Once areas that need additional practice are identified, a personalized program is then developed for them.

"In instances where a student faces challenges in a specific area, supplemental workbooks are provided to strengthen their understanding," Rehmat said. "Conversely, for students excelling at their current level, we introduce new concepts to keep them engaged and challenged."

This flexible approach to the curriculum empowers students to learn at their own pace, ensuring a personalized and effective learning experience.

The English curriculum is a comprehensive language program that develops communication skills through targeted practice in grammar, vocabulary, reading comprehension and writing. The math curriculum includes content areas such as numbers, arithmetic, measurement, equations and probability.

There is also a critical thinking program that includes content areas such as patterns and relationships, geometry, problem solving, measurement and reasoning.

The Mehdis' goal is to partner with parents and schools in the local community to continue to address every child's educational needs in a positive way.

"We are excited to be a part of the vibrant Riverstone community and consider it a privilege to collaborate with the students here," Rehmat said. "We look forward to continuing our close partnership with the parents, students and educators in this area."

Tennis Court Etiquette

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.

Tennis Court Reminders

- Court #6 at The Club at Riverstone and court #9 at Riverstone Blvd are designated as walk on courts. They are available for walk-on play during tennis court hours. Please be mindful when using the courts for walk-on play and limit your time to a maximum of 2 hours.
- Please remember all tennis court reservations are now available through the Riverstone app only.
- Remember that court reservations will be forfeited after 15 minutes of not showing up for scheduled start time.
- Tennis courts are for the use of tennis or pickleball play only. Any other sports or equipment are strictly prohibited. For more information refer to rule #4 at the Resource Center under Community Info.

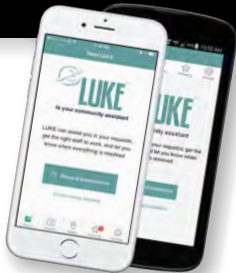

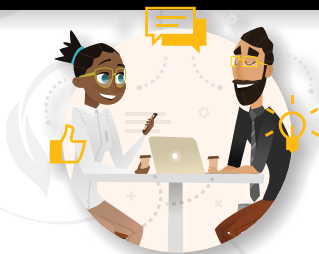
