Riverstone Homeowners Association has volunteer opportunities on the following three resident committees:

- Membership on a committee is restricted to members (homeowners) with the Riverstone HOA
- No paid staff of Riverstone HOA can serve as a voting member in any committee position.
- Spouses or adults living in the same residence cannot serve on the same committee.
- Committee members may not have outstanding balances or deed restriction violations with Riverstone HOA.
