

VOLUNTEER APPLICATION

Riverstone Homeowners Association has volunteer opportunities on the following four resident committees:

- Landscape Committee assists with landscape-related projects, yard of the month, lawn care information, and other projects which help reflect residents' pride in the community.
- **Modification Sub Committee** responsible for reviewing applications related to modifications of residential properties and help to develop policy and guidelines for the Community. This committee shall meet monthly or as needed.
- Gated Neighborhood Committee enable residents to be involved and advise the Management/Board regarding the desired services and related costs for their respective gated neighborhoods. This committee shall meet at least once a year and as needed beyond that.
- **Finance Committee** works alongside the HOA Staff and Board to review short and long-term investments of Riverstone HOA funds, Riverstone's HOA Annual Operating Budget, capital requirements, reserve studies, and insurance coverage.
- **Foundation Committee** works alongside the HOA Staff and Board to review grant applications and select projects and programs believed to best reflect the needs and interests of the community. Foundation fees are primarily used to fund community events, health and wellness, technology, education, the environment, and enhancements to infrastructure within the community.

The following minimum qualifications are required to be considered for a committee:

- Membership on a committee is restricted to members (homeowners) with the Riverstone HOA.
- No paid staff of Riverstone HOA can serve as a voting member in any committee position.
- Spouses or adults living in the same residence cannot serve on the same committee.
- Committee members may not have outstanding balances or deed restriction violations with Riverstone HOA.
