Welcome to Riverstone! To have amenity cards made for you, please email us the following:

- 1. Completed amenity card form (found at www.riverstone.com)
- 2. Deed or closing disclosure

- 3. Individual headshot pictures of each resident over the age of 5. Please label each photo with their name and date of birth.
- 4. Proof of identification (State ID, Driver's License, passport, etc) for all residents over the age of 18.
- 5. Anyone over the age of 18 whose name is not listed on the deed will need to provide additional proof of residence. Examples of acceptable Proof of Residency may include car insurance, utility bill, cell phone bill, etc. and must include the resident's name and current home address.

Each account will receive up to 3 adult amenity cards and at no charge. Each additional adult amenity card after the first 3 cards is \$15.00.

The replacement of lost Amenity Cards is available for \$15 each.

Notes from the Compliance Department

Riverstone's Compliance staff meets regularly to review community compliance issues that arise throughout the course of the year. We would like to remind residents of the following Deed Restriction guidelines:

Pets—Pet owners are reminded that dogs should be on a leash at all times when out walking within the community. Additionally, residents are asked to be respectful of their neighbors when walking their dogs and to pick up after them. Nothing "stinks" worse than stepping in a surprise in your yard or on the sidewalk.



A Reminder About Pets: Per the Riverstone Deed Restrictions, no animals, livestock, or poultry of any kind may be raised, bred, kept, or permitted on any Lot, with the exception of a maximum of three (3) dogs, cats or other usual and common household pets (excluding in such maximum number, fish and birds). No pets shall be kept, bred or maintained for any commercial purpose. Animal control authorities shall be permitted to enter the Properties to patrol and remove pets. Pets shall be registered, licensed and inoculated as required by law. *Trash Cans*—Other than on trash collection days, trash cans should not be visible from the street or by adjacent neighbors. Residents may place trash cans (and recycle bins) curbside the evening prior to collection. Following trash pick-up days, cans must be put away and out of public view.



Landscape Tips—February is a good time to apply a turf fertilization with a pre & post-emergent herbicide to help control weeds in your lawn. This is also a good time for trimming trees and shrubs for the Spring. Applying mulch to your landscaping beds and tree wells will also help to enhance the appearance of your yard.

Get Ready for Kidventure Summer Camp!

When is a summer camp not a summer camp? When it's a Kidventure! Beginning June 5th, Riverstone will be hosting a series of Kidventure day camps designed to foster confidence, relationships and values.

For nearly three decades, Kidventure has been providing the chance for kids to grow, learn and be a part of something rewarding said Mike Mc-Donell, President of Kidventure.

"Kidventure has always provided the most fun, most exciting summer



camp programs, but with a greater purpose," he said. "That is what sets Kidventure apart from all other camp programs. We design everything we do at Kidventure to have a purpose and to help grow our kids."

Kidventure is bringing their Explorers camps to Riverstone. The weekly camps are geared toward kids entering first through fifth grade. Campers will be divided into small groups of no more than 10 children by age. Camps take place from 8:00am to 3:00 Monday through Friday. There is an option for a Post Camp from 3:00pm to 6:00pm. The cost is \$320 per week, per camper.

McDonell said that each week will have a unique curriculum, but the focus will be on bringing kids together, fostering new friendships and providing learning adventures.

"Camp isn't just a place to have fun and hang out," McDonell said. "Camp is a powerful opportunity to teach values, stay active and foster friendships. We accomplish this with an all-adult team of camp counselors, a rich and intentional curriculum and 29 years of experience providing summer camp in Houston."

Among the many activities explorers will engage in are athletics, art, team building, rock climbing, archery, field trips, swimming, special guests, yoga, fine and gross motor skills, and much more.

Riverstone Business Spotlight



Riverstone residents love their Cajun-style seafood. Fresh, succulent with just the right amount of spice. Where can they get it? Happy Crab.

The restaurant opened last February, featuring an array of traditional Cajun seafood offerings.

"We offer authentic and delicious Cajun seafood," said Danny Lin, manager of Happy Crab. "You can enjoy boiled and fried seafood, as well as oysters, fried rice, noodles, chicken wings and more."

This is the third Happy Crab location opened by Lin. The first two are in Florida.

"I was born in China," Lin said. "It was a small town by the sea. I love seafood. When I came to America in 2002, I started working in the restaurant business. I worked in restaurants for 18 years and then I was able to open my own business."

He opened his first Happy Crab in Tampa in 2020, quickly followed by another location

in St. Petersburg. When deciding where to open his third location, he took the advice of a cousin living in Houston.

"Part of my family lives in Sugar Land," he said. "When we decided to open a third location in Houston, my cousin recommended Riverstone. It's a great location between Sugar Land and Missouri City. It's also a great neighborhood."

Happy Crab is a busy place particularly the first six months of the year.

"We are busy from the middle of January to the middle of August," Lin said. It slows down a bit and then picks up when the season starts again."

That's not surprising considering crawfish is one of their top sellers. Other favorites include snow crab, headless shrimp, fried catfish and fried shrimp. Lin's favorites are scallops and king crab. He said everyone should try the house special which features crab and headless shrimp.

Happy Crab also offers a make-your-own combo as well as a party menu. Hosts can choose from four offerings, including the P1 that features snow crab, Dungeness crab, shrimp, sausage, corn, potatoes and eggs. The largest party platter, P4, builds on that to include snow crab, king crab, clams, lobster tail, crawfish and black mussels.

For those in the mood for cocktails, there is a full bar serving up favorites such as Pina Coladas, Mai Tais and Long Island Ice Teas. Martinis, domestic and imported beers and wine are also available.

Happy Crab is kid-friendly and has a party section that can seat up to 50 people.

Fort Bend County Nonprofit Spotlight



Education opens doors and provides opportunities that lead to success. Sometimes, there are barriers to receiving that education. Fort Bend Hope is dedicated to removing them.

The inspiration for Fort Bend Hope began as a mission of Faith Methodist in 2013. In the begin-

ning, members simply wished to create multi-generational change for the community by providing a hand-up for those who need it and not merely a handout. From backpacks of food for children in need to in-school mentoring at Jackson Elementary, the group searched for a way to make the greatest impact. These experiences led them to focus solely on education.

"We believe education is the key to breaking the cycle of generational poverty," said Adam Yates, Executive Director for Fort Bend Hope. "It can change the arc of someone's life, a family's life or a community's life. It can unlock the American Dream. At the end of the day, education opens doors and equals options so that people have choices with regards to what they wish to do with their lives versus doing something because it is all they can do."



Fort Bend Hope was incorporated in 2016. In 2017, they moved into an unoccupied former restaurant in Rosenburg that was purchased and donated to them. While the initial plan was to hold an afterschool program, they realized that many parents

could not participate in their children's education because English was not their first language. They decided to address this by offering English as a Second Language classes.

Over the years, Fort Bend Hope has grown and now provides ESL, GED, citizenship, computer literacy, afterschool programs and summer reading camps. They even created a virtual learning center during the pandemic.

All classes are led by volunteers. Yates said that the relationships formed with the teachers and other class members are the key to student success.

"There are going to be times where people want to give up," he said. "What keeps them going is the fact they have formed relationships with their classmates and teachers. When you know there are other people there that believe in you and are pulling for you, you are much less likely to give up on yourself when the going gets tough."

The successes are many, including a single mother who needed to get her GED so she could get a job and a woman who spoke no English but became fluent after taking Fort Bend Hope classes. Another woman—trained as an engineer in her home country—wanted to improve her English rapidly so she could obtain a job.

"Through a lot of work, she was able to become conversational in English," Yates said. "She then started going to job interviews and recording them so she could come back and review them one-on-one





with her teacher to learn how to improve. Now? She has a job with the world leader in her field using the skills she was trained for in her home country."

Last year, Fort Bend Hope had more than 110 students helped by more than 50 volunteers. Volunteers perform a number of tasks, including teaching, social media, volunteer appreciation, data tracking and maintenance.

"Basically, if you wish to help people proceed with their education, we probably have a great spot for you," Yates said. "As a volunteer, you want to know you are making a difference and that you matter to the mission. At Fort Bend Hope, our volunteers know that."

Yates wants people to know that the Fort Bend Hope building isn't that far from Riverstone.

"I mention that simply because some people think Rosenberg can be a ways out here," he said. "I promise it is not. If someone has interest in volunteering or donating to Fort Bend Hope, they can go to www. fortbendhope.org and click on the 'volunteer' or 'give now' buttons."

- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.
