Missouri City National Night Out

Missouri City officials, staff and citizens will join forces in conjunction with communities across the nation in support of the 2014 Annual National Night Out from 5 to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, Oct. 7. Citizens in all parts of the Missouri City community are asked to turn on their outside lights, get outdoors and spend the evening visiting with their neighbors. "Citizens will have access to police vehicles and tactical equipment, so please come out and see our S.W.A.T. Team, Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Team, Bike Patrol, ATV Search Team and Dive Team," Missouri City Police Officer Evett Kelly said. "The Missouri City Fire Department will also have a ladder truck and rescue boat on display." The City's official NNO celebration on Oct. 7 will take place in the Target Store parking lot, 6000 Hwy 6 at FM 1092. Fort Bend ISD Announces 2014 District and Campus TEA Accountability Ratings

Fort Bend ISD received its 2014 District and campus accountability ratings from the Texas Education Agency (TEA), and 69 of the 70 campuses (98.6 percent) received the rating Met Standard. The District also received a rating of Met Standard. Statewide, 90 percent of district and charters received the rating Met Standard. All campuses and districts in Texas were labeled as either Met Standard or Improvement Required. The 2014 ratings are the second year ratings were released under the state's new accountability system based on the State of Texas

Assessment of Academic Readiness (STAAR).
