

Mosquito Spraying

With the rain the area has been getting and the high temperatures, we know that mosquitos have come out in full force throughout the state. The Association has been in contact with both Fort Bend County and Missouri City regarding everyone's concerns and to see how they are responding to this influx in mosquitoes. Both have stated that they are aware of the situation and have increased mosquito spraying to twice per week. If you would like to keep up with the spraying schedule, you are now able to do so visiting www.fortbendcountytx.gov.

To reduce mosquito breeding, we recommend getting rid of standing water, where mosquitoes lay eggs and larvae grow, such as in bird baths, pet bowls, kiddy pools, flower pots and gutters.
