FLIGHT IN RIVERSTONE APRIL 1-15

Birds unlike any other have settled in Riverstone, at least temporarily, as the award-winning "Flight" artwork will be on display at The Club at Riverstone through April 15.

Sculpted by Dale Rogers of Massachusetts and winner of the 2012 ArtPrize Urban Space Juried Award, "Flight" showcases nine stainless-steel birds with 12-foot wingspans. The 200-pound birds are displayed in a serpentine pattern 12 to 15 feet off of the ground.

The community artwork is part of Houston's Largest Home Tour activities, which is being held in 10 communities of The Johnson Development Corp. during April.

HOA CORNER

We have had an influx of concerns about soliciting in the Riverstone Community and understand how this can be a nuisance. The Association has been looking into the matter and speaking with local law enforcement. Unfortunately, the Association has no control over soliciting activities since the streets and roadways within the community are public access ways owned by the county and soliciting is not against the law in Fort Bend County. We have been informed that officers can only make contact with the solicitors and ask for identity, if they are able to locate them. They can then ask them to leave the community, but cannot do anything if they don't leave or come back on a different day. Of course, if an individual or individuals are in the process of breaking the law, a law enforcement officer can take immediate action.

Your Association recommends the following actions that every owner can take to discourage unwelcome soliciting in the community.

- Report all suspicious persons to Fort Bend County Precinct 4, 281-341-4665 and request the deputies on duty be made aware of your concerns.
- Refuse to make use of solicitors' offers and refuse to patronize any company being marketed in this manner.
- If you are able to obtain the companies information or address, please notify the Association. We will be happy to send them a letter advising them to discontinue door to door soliciting (we will also remind them of the community newsletter and/or the other avenues for marketing purposes). Please be reminded that this may not discontinue them from coming back.
- Individual homeowners have the ability to place a small (2 x 8" or 3 x 10") "No Trespassing/No Soliciting" sign at the entry to their homes. Should a solicitor continue to leave flyers, the homeowner then has the authority to file charges against the Solicitor/ Company for trespassing on private property.
- Promptly remove flyers that are placed on your front or garage doors.
- Notify the Post Office of all soliciting flyers placed on mailboxes.






