Wild Hogs

Many residents have noticed that their lawns or shrub beds appear to be uprooted in the morning as a result of wild (feral) hogs in the area. The hogs are looking for food as they are omnivores and consume both plant and animal matter. Owners can put down a treatment that prevents grub worms. This may help deter the hogs from digging in their yard. There are companies who provide grub worm treatment services. Check out lawnserviceadvisor.com to find local lawn maintenance companies. Additionally, products like Bayer Advanced Grub Control, Milky Spore, and Scotts GrubEx can be found at local home improvement stores. You will need to not only treat your lawn but your shrub and flower beds as well.

The hogs have been a growing issue in Fort Bend County for some time now and unfortunately will continue to be as they breed several times a year. Residents have expressed concerns over what measures the homeowners association is taking to address the matter. As specified in the Notice to Homebuyers Agreement, the Riverstone HOA is not responsible for the nuisance of these wild hogs as the HOA does not manage wildlife affairs.

The Association has been informed that the hogs are in their natural habitat. Since the Brazos River runs through Fort Bend County which includes a lot of undeveloped areas adjacent to the river such as portions of Riverstone, Sienna, The George Ranch, Brazos Bend State Park and other large areas that are still rural in nature, a natural habitat for the hogs is created that obviously covers tens of thousands of acres that are unregulated and available for the hogs to roam across. As development moves forward, hogs and other wildlife are being driven from their natural habitat.

Residents are discouraged from trapping the hogs as there is an element of danger associated with any wild animal. Neither the Game Warden nor Animal Control will collect trapped hogs. This is an unfortunate situation, but the only way to eliminate them from our neighborhoods is to eliminate what they are looking for, food i.e., Grub Worms.

The 17-acre Club at Riverstone is a recreational hub for Riverstone residents. The complex is home to the community's third pool, The Waterpark at Riverstone. The Live Oak Ballroom

Seated Capacity: 84 people. Standing Capacity: 100 people.

The Live Oak Ballroom is located on the first floor and has spectacular views of a beautiful lake through walls of windows. It can be used as one large room, or divide into three smaller rooms. Rental of this space will also allow you to use the back patio area for your event. There is a catering kitchen and serving bar available at no extra charge. Available seven days a week to Riverstone residents only.

The Elm Room

Capacity: 24 people.

The Elm Room is located on the first floor and has spectacular views of a beautiful lake through a wall of windows. This is a small room ideal for meetings, baby showers,or birthday parties. Available seven days a week to Riverstone residents only.

Rental Procedures



How to Rent The Club at Riverstone Facilities

Residents may rent one room, or all of the Club, based upon availability. It important to note that The Club at Riverstone serves as the primary location for Riverstone Foundation sponsored community events, leisure classes, committee meetings, social club meetings, and resident rentals. To check space availability and request a specific date/time for your private event please follow the steps below:

- 1. Login into your profile on the Resident Intranet and click on the link called "Resident Rentals".
- 2. Review the "Rooms & Fees" document and "Rental Policy" document found online in the rental information and forms section. These documents will provide you with all the policies, guidelines, and costs related to renting a space at The Club at Riverstone.
- 3. Decide which date/time and spaces you would like to request. Please make sure when deciding a date and time that you are within the room availability stated in the "Rental Policy" document. It is also important to note that the minimum rental time frame for the Live Oak Ballroom and Elm Room is three hours.
- 4. Request your desired space, date, and time by clicking the button on the "Resident Rentals" online page. (Please note that once you complete the request you will receive a confirmation email. It will clearly state that you have only requested that rental and that the request still needs to be confirmed by the event team.) Alternatively, download the necessary forms (or pick them up at The Club at Riverstone), fill out the "Rental Application & Agreement", and drop them off at The Club at Riverstone during business hours.
- 5. At this point, please allow the event team a maximum of ten business days to confirm the availability of your requested space, date, and times. They will contact you within that time frame to set up an appointment at The Club at Riverstone.
- 6. At the appointment, they will review the "Rental Policy" document with you, have you complete the "Rental Application & Agreement", and collect your full payment (checks and credit cards accepted). They will also discuss with you the recommended layouts for the amount of people you are having and note your specific event needs.
- 7. Once all the appropriate paperwork has been submitted, you will have completed the reservation process! Now it is time to focus on your other event needs. Feel free to ask the event team questions and for referrals to vendors you may need (such as a linen company, caterer, DJ, band, etc.).




