

# HOA Corner Winter Weather Lawn Care

**Lawn Care:** During the winter season, it is a good time to apply a winterizer type fertilizer to the lawn to keep it green and healthy. Our St. Augustine lawns really do not stop growing in our climate. The top growth does become dormant, but the roots will continue to grow and store nutrients for next spring. We have to watch for Brown Patch Fungus activity as well, as it is normally active from mid-August until April. Water your lawns only as needed this time of year because overwatering lawns causes the fungus to spread. If needed, there are fungicides labeled for this disease. Brown Patch causes brown circular patterns in the lawn. If the outer edges of the circle are orange in color, the fungus is active and spreading. It does not kill the roots of the grass plant, but it does cause the grass blades to die off. The lawn will recover, but depending on the amount of damage, it may take until mid-summer to restore itself. Fungicide applications will reduce the spreading of the disease, but must be applied several times in 30 day intervals to minimize the damage.

Tree and Shrub Care: Fertilize your trees and shrubs to promote health during winter stresses and to provide nutrients for next spring's growth and burst of color in your flowering foliage. This is also the best time of year to plant any new shrubs and perennials. Fall and winter color, such as Pansies, Snap Dragons, Dianthus, and Kale should be installed now. Mulch all landscape now with hardwood mulch to retain moisture and minimize weeds in beds. Always follow label instructions to make sure you are applying the correct product to accomplish the task at hand. Make sure it is labeled for the insect, disease, weed or other pest that you are trying to control as well labeled to be used on the correct plant.

### **HOA Dues**

Homeowners Association dues begin the 1st of January of each year, and after the 31st of January, dues are considered late. The use of check or money order is required, as FirstService Residential does not accept cash or credit cards. Residents do have some options as to how they may pay their HOA dues. The first option is to send it by check or money order to FirstService Residential's corporate office located at 5295 Hollister Street, Houston, TX

> 77040. If mailing to the corporate office, residents must be sure to include their Riverstone prop-

erty address. The second option is to look at the coupon that is enclosed when the dues are sent out. If the resident wishes to use this coupon, he or she must mail the dues to the P.O. Box number on the coupon. These will go directly to a lock box at the bank instead. The bank will then scan all checks to the corporate office. Lastly, residents can visit the onsite office located at The Club at Riverstone and pay there.

Per the deed restrictions: "Customary seasonal decorations for national holidays are permitted for a maximum of twelve (12) days or thirty (30) days, in the case of Christmas, subject to the right of the Residential ARC to specify a maximum size and other guidelines for decorations". ALL holiday decor must be removed on or before January 24th.






