HOA Corner Parking

Street and sidewalk parking has become a concern for many Riverstone homeowners. Although the deed restrictions do prohibit street parking, the County allows it. Federal, State, City, and County laws overrule the deed restrictions; therefore the Association is unable to enforce this restriction. If you notice a vehicle that is parked illegally, please contact your local Constable or Sheriff. Furthermore, if you feel that the situation poses as a potential traffic or safety hazard, please contact your local Police Department.



In the event that a car is parked on the sidewalk, residents

should be aware that this is illegal and a violation of the deed restrictions. If your car is found as an obstruction on the sidewalk, you could receive a citation from the Constable and a letter from the Association.

We understand that many families may have several vehicles. We do ask, when possible, that you please try to park your cars in your garage and that when additional vehicles are parked on the driveway to pull up far enough to keep from blocking the flow of the sidewalk.

Each person buying into a deed restricted community agrees, by virtue of purchase, to adhere to the deed restrictions. Beyond that, however, the Association would like to encourage everyone to be a good neighbor. Respect for all Riverstone residents is what helps to build community.

Developer Corner Big Plans for 2016!

Even though Riverstone saw several firsts in 2015, one thing remained constant—our community is again ranked the No. 1 top-selling development in Texas!
