## **Annual Assessments**

With the end of the year fast approaching, we wanted to send out a friendly reminder to be on the lookout for the 2017 annual assessment coupons that will be sent out soon. All annual assessments are due no later than January 31st. They are considered late if received after that date and will incur monthly late fees on the account. Here are a few ways to pay the annual assessment:

- 1. If you wish to make a payment online or over the phone, please visit fsresidential.com. (Select the Make a Payment option in the top left corner for further instructions.)
- 2. Payments (check or money order) may be mailed to the address listed on the coupon. Please allow time for processing, as these will be going to a lock box at the bank. The bank will then scan all checks to the corporate office.
- 3. Lastly, residents can visit the onsite office located at The Club at Riverstone to submit payments. The use of check or money order is required, as FirstService Residential does not accept cash or credit cards. Please also be aware that the payments accepted at the onsite office are not processed there. All payments are mailed to the corporate office for processing and may take a little longer.

If you do not receive a statement for your HOA dues by January 1st, please contact the FirstService Residential team at 713.332.4750 or stop by The Club at Riverstone. Please note that it is the homeowner's responsibility to both set up their mailbox with the post office (if you are a new owner who has not done this yet) and check your mail or provide a correct billing address.

## Parking

With the growth of residential housing, street and sidewalk parking has become a concern for many Riverstone homeowners. This is a friendly reminder to ensure residents are aware of State Law (TRC 545.303) covering vehicular parking in the correct direction.

#### Texas State Law TRC 545.303 states:

"Park Over 18 Inches Away From Curb or Edge of Roadway— An operator who stops or parks on a two-way roadway shall do so with the right-hand wheels of the vehicle parallel to and within 18 inches of the right-hand curb or edge of the roadway."
