HOA Corner Home Improvements

The Association would like to send a friendly reminder to submit an ARC application for all exterior modifications, including any replanting of foliage due to the recent freeze. Per the deed restrictions, all exterior modifications re-

quire Architectural Review Committee approval prior to any changes being made. Applications can be obtained from the Riverstone Intranet or by visiting the Homeowner's Association on-site office. Additionally, please review the Modification Guidelines (also available on the Intranet) for a wealth of information and guidance involving common ARC requests.

Some common exterior modifications which require ARC approval include, but are not limited to the following: planting or relocating trees, landscape lighting, permanent basketball goals, exterior painting, pergolas, pools, patio expansions and enclosures, outdoor kitchens, property gates, landscape borders, fountains, driveway modifications, storm doors, and solar panels. If you currently have made any exterior modification to your home without ARC approval, an ARC application must be submitted and approved for the existing modification.
