

HOA Corner Home Improvements

Spring is nearly upon us and that usually means nicer weather and spring cleaning. Here are some tips and 'how to's' for sprucing up the exterior of your home and property.

Cleaning the Garage Door

Materials Needed: Pressure Washer, Dish Soap, Multi-Purpose Terry Towels, **Bucket, and Water**

Now you are ready! Start by putting a little dish soap in the bucket. Using your water hose, fill the bucket with water. Dip the towel in the soapy water and thoroughly wipe down your garage door. After that, use the pressure washer to blast away the soap, dinge, and dirt. Don't forget the trim!

Cleaning the Trash Can(s)

Materials Needed: Dish Soap, Pressure Washer, and Garbage Odor Eliminator Remove all trash from the can(s). Lay the can(s) on its side. Squirt dish soap in the garbage can. Use the pressure washer to clean and rinse it out. Pour in a garbage odor eliminator and you are finished!

Cleaning Exterior Mold/Mildew

Materials Needed: Pressure Washer, Scrub Brush, White Vinegar, Water, Bucket, and Possibly a Ladder Pressure washing can be a very good way to clean exterior mold/mildew from your home. Another option is to scrub it by hand by using a durable scrub brush and a 70/30 solution of water and white vinegar. Start from the top and work your way downward. Remember to wear protective rubber gloves when working with vinegar or other solutions, and also take in account the plants below where the solution will be dripping. Just like bleach, vinegar can harm or kill plant life.

Cleaning Out the Gutter

Materials Needed: Water Hose, Garden Gloves, Scooper, and Ladder

First blast water with the hose down the gutter to help you figure out if the spout is clogged or if your gutters are leaky. Once you have verified your gutter is not leaking, you're going to need to get rid of all the leaves, twigs, and other gunk that has made a home in your gutter. Using a scoop may help remove any leaves. If you're doing this by hand, wearing gloves is recommended to help prevent cuts from exposed, jagged metal. Additionally, always use caution when using a ladder!
