Constable Corner

Greetings on behalf of Constable Trever Nehls and the Fort Bend County Precinct 4 Constable's Office. We want you to be aware that summer time temperatures are here with the daily average reaching in the 80's and 90's. In the first responder world, one call we fear the most is responding to the call of a child or pet left in a vehicle unattended. Although accidents do happen, the results can be catastrophic for everyone involved, from the family, to the first responders and the community. When the temperature outside is 80 to 90 degrees the temperature inside the vehicle can reach 115-120 degrees in twenty minutes and as high as 130 degrees within an hour. If you see a child or pet in a car unattended call 911, find help immediately and ask someone to notify the surrounding businesses.

Tennis Court Etiquette

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court. Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.

Tennis Court Reminders

- Remember, only authorized personnel are allowed to teach at both University Blvd and Riverstone Blvd tennis courts.
- Court #2 at The Club at Riverstone has been designated as a teaching court. (Please make note when reserving court #1 that a high traffic flow and an abundance of tennis balls may be possible due to tennis lessons on adjacent court).
- Please keep in mind that rule #11 prohibits the booking of back to back times on the same court.

Did You Know? The French Open tennis tournament begins on Monday, May 22nd. The French Open also known as Roland Garros was named after a French aviator and fighter pilot during World War I. The French Open is the second leg of the four major tournamnets known as the Grand Slam, it's the only major played on a clay tennis court.
