

Deed Restriction Reminders

Exterior Lighting

The Community Standards Team would like to remind residents the following regulations when it comes to exterior lighting.

- Landscape lights/pathway lights, where the light source is shown, are not permitted.
- All landscape lighting, white in color only, should receive Architectural Review Committee approval.
- Directional lights must be aimed so as not to shine in the windows of neighboring homes.
- Additional exterior lighting should not be of a wattage or lumen count which will affect neighboring homes.
- Light source should not be visible to the public.
- Security lights must be attached to the eaves of the house, preferably garage or corners. (Mercury vapor, fluorescent, and sodium halide are not permitted. No colored lighting is acceptable.)
- Yard lights may be gas or electric. Single lamp only. Maximum height 6'. May be in front or back. Gas or electric lights must be black, brown or white, depending on color of house and determination of suitable color will be the decision of the Architectural Review Committee.



- Flood lights are not allowed.
- Any modification of the type of lighting on the interior of the home that changes the normal color of white lighting to something of a color that can be viewed by the public must receive prior approval.

Get Farm Fresh Vegetables Delivered Each Week



box contains 8-10 seasonal varieties of nutritious, delicious produce. You will also receive a members-only newsletter telling you what's in your box, current events at the farm, storage techniques, recipes curated by local chefs and invites to member events on the farm.

If you are going out of town on vacation or can not pick up your box, you can simply login to your account and put your share on hold. It is very flexible and user friendly. Why register? Not only are you providing your family with a nutrient rich, delicious box of produce, but you are also supporting the growing local food movement in our region. - 🚯 When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court. Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling reservation when you know that you will not be using it.




