Compliance Department Updates

Residents are reminded that if you are planning to replace your fence or sections of your fence, to submit an ARC application for review by the ARC committee. If the fence is between you and a neighbor (a shared fence) it is strongly recommended that you talk with your neighbor prior to any fence work being done. Fences must be replaced with the same material and style as the existing fence. Any changes require approval from the ARC. Fence stains must also be submitted for and approved by the ARC. Your fence may need to be pressure washed from time to time to remove mildew and/or dirt, or if your fence stain has faded and peeled. Driveway gates must be the Riverstone standard and must receive approval from the ARC prior to installation. Please ensure that your fence is in good repair. Check to make sure there are no missing or loose pickets or that your fence is not leaning. If you have a metal fence, please make sure that it is not rusted and that the paint is not faded or peeling. Metal fence paint must be black semigloss only.

Please note, the Modification Guidelines have been updated

and are now called the Architectural Review Committee Guidelines. Please visit our website www.rshoa.org for more information and to download a copy of the revised guidelines. Feel free to contact the compliance department at compliancedept@rshoa.org if you have any questions.

Do you enjoy volunteering? Are you civic-minded and enjoy building your community? Have a mind for business? Riverstone Homeowners Association, Inc. is currently accepting nominations for a Resident Director to serve on the Board of Directors. To qualify for candidacy, a nominee must be the Owner of a Lot within Riverstone and have not been convicted of a felony within the last 20 years. The candidate receiving the most votes will be elected and serve a two-year term on the Board. This is an un-paid, volunteer position.

Riverstone owners interested in running for the Resident Director position for the 2020-2022 year should complete the "willingness to serve" nomination form that is included in this Reflections newsletter and return it along with a color photograph via email to AshleyB@rshoa.org or by hand delivery to the Association Office located at 18353 University



Boulevard. A fillable version of this form is also available on our website at www.rshoa.org under Community Info > Resource Center and selecting "2019 HOA Board Election Info". The deadline for nominations is 5 p.m., Monday, September 30th.

An election packet will be mailed to Owners on October 21st with voting instructions. The voting period will end on November 8th. The results of the election will be announced at the Riverstone Homeowners Association Annual Meeting to be held in November.

What's Involved with Serving on the HOA Board?

Many people love living in Planned Communities like Riverstone for the great amenities offered, such as common swimming pools, clubhouse, tennis courts and our lifestyle team. Communities like ours cannot function, however, unless there are dedicated homeowners willing to help run the community by serving on our homeowners' association board of directors. You might hesitate to serve on the board if you don't know what a board member does, or what's expected.

Your Fiduciary Obligation as an HOA Board Member

In general, corporate law gives board members of a nonprofit corporation the fiduciary duty to the other members of the HOA (all the other homeowners). In practice, this means that HOA board members must:

- · Act in good faith, and in a fair and consistent manner.
- Act in the best interests of the HOA as a whole (and avoid any conflict of interests).
- Be informed prior to acting.
- Not take any actions without proper authority.
- Not take negligent, or willfully harmful actions.

Other Obligations and Duties

Beyond your fiduciary obligation, the specific duties and responsibilities of an HOA board member include some of the following:

- Attend HOA Board Meetings and Workshops as well as other meetings as necessary.
- Maintain Confidentiality as required by law.



- Provide for the operation, care, upkeep and maintenance of all Common Area, including entering contacts to provide for such.
- Adopt rules and regulations as necessary.
- Enforcement powers, such as the right to assess fees for delinquent dues or for rule violations.
- Adopt the Annual Budget and set Assessments.
- Oversee Riverstone HOA management (which handles day-to-day operations).

Tennis Court Etiquette

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.

Tennis Court Reminders

- Court #6 at The Club at Riverstone and court #9 at Riverstone Blvd are designated as walk on courts.
- Only authorized professionals are allowed to teach at both Riverstone's locations.
- Please remember all tennis court reservations are now available through the Riverstone app only. Appointment Plus is no longer available.
