



# **Constable Corner**

Constable Trever Nehls and the Fort Bend County Precinct 4 Constable's Office would like to assist in preparing for a safe Halloween with the tips below.

### HALLOWEEN SAFETY TIPS

### **Walk Safely**

- 1. Cross the street at corners, using traffic signals and crosswalks.
- Look left, right and left again when crossing and keep looking as you cross.
- Put electronic devices down and keep heads up and walk, don't run, across the street.
- 4. Teach children to make eye contact with drivers before crossing in front of them.
- Always walk on sidewalks or paths. If there are no sidewalks, walk facing traffic as far to the left as possible. Children should walk on direct routes with the fewest street crossings.
- 6. Watch for cars that are turning or backing up. Teach children to never dart out into the street or cross between parked cars.

### **Keep Costumes Both Creative and Safe**

- 1. Decorate costumes and bags with reflective tape or stickers and, if possible, choose light colors.
- 2. Have kids carry glow sticks or flashlights to help them see and be seen by drivers.

### **Drive Extra Safely on Halloween**

- Slow down and be especially alert in residential neighborhoods. Children are excited on Halloween and may move in unpredictable ways.
- 2. Take extra time to look for kids at intersections, on medians and on curbs.
- 3. Enter and exit driveways slowly and carefully.

# **Annual Assessments**

With the end of the year fast approaching, we want to send out a reminder to be on the lookout for the 2019 annual assessment information that will be mailed to all Riverstone property owners next month. Assessments are levied annually to enable the HOA to pay Association Expenses; including maintaining and improving common areas, as well as other general purposes that promote the common benefit for Riverstone residents.

All Annual Assessments are due on January 1, 2020.



# What's a Certificate of Compliance

A Certificate of Compliance (or CoC) is a letter stating the status of the deed restriction status of the exterior of a home. Before every home is sold, we personally inspect the outside of every home, front and back yards. The home will then be found as In Compliance, Out of Compliance, or In Compliance with Conditions. This is simply an informative letter for the buyer, it will not hold up the sales process, and a home Out of Compliance can still be sold. However, it would then be up the new owner to bring the home into compliance with deed restrictions. You can request at Certificate of Compliance on your home by visiting https://rshoa.condocerts.com/resale/ or www.condocerts.com.

# DID YOU KNOW

Have you ever bought a home in a Deed Restricted community like Riverstone that had violations and you didn't know it? No one likes a surprise like that! In order to help the sales process in Riverstone, we require a Certificate of Compliance to be completed with every Transfer of Ownership.

# **Architectural Review Committee (ARC) Updates**

The Architectural Review Committee recently revised the modification guidelines which are now called the Architectural Review Committee Guidelines. These revised guidelines are now available on the HOA website. Residents are encouraged to review these guidelines when submitting an application for a modification to their property. As a reminder any modification to the front or rear of the property must be submitted and reviewed by the ARC Committee prior to installation.

The Riverstone Compliance Department encourages all residents to take a few minutes and look over their property for any potential Deed Restriction issues that may result in a violation letter being sent out.

Here are some helpful reminders:

- Any landscape modifications or additions to the front or rear yard requires approval from the ARC.
- Please trim trees over the sidewalk and street so that the trees do not impact pedestrians, vehicles or block street signs.
- Pressure wash driveway and walkways/sidewalks to remove stains and/or dirt and mildew build up.

- During the summer months yards may need to be mowed and edged every 7 to 10 days. Remember to remove weeds from your landscaping beds and tree wells.
- Keep your trash and recycle bin out of public view on non-trash days.
   This includes any trash bags. All trash must be in a trash container.
- Remove trees stakes if they are over 1 year old.
- Remove any dirt and/or mildew on the outside of the house.
- Portable basketball goals are not permitted in the front yard. They are permitted in the back yard of non-view lots, but must receive ARC approval.
- · Please pick up after your pets.

### **Tennis Court Etiquette**

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an
  adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball
  when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.

### **Tennis Court Reminders**

- Court #6 at The Club at Riverstone and court #9 at Riverstone Blvd are designated as walk on courts.
- Only authorized professionals are allowed to teach at both Riverstone's locations.
- Please remember all tennis court reservations are now available through the Riverstone app only. Appointment Plus is no longer available.

### **Unauthorized Tennis Lessons**

Recently there has been an increase of tennis lessons at Riverstone by unauthorized tennis pros. Please keep in mind that HOA rules prohibits the teaching of tennis lessons by unauthorized persons.


