# **Check Out Your Resident Portal**

Did you know that you have access to your HOA account through our Resident Portal? The Resident Portal provides homeowners



with convenient, real time, 24-hour access to your account where you will be able to view and update your homeowner information, view account information and make payments, view compliance violations, architectural requests, and more!

You can access the portal from our website at www.rshoa.org by clicking the Resident Account Portal tab on the top of your screen. When you are logging into the web portal for the first time, you will need to select the "Create login" link. You will then enter your account number and email address. If you do not have your Account Number, please contact us at customercare@rshoa.org. It will also be printed on the 2020 Assessment statement that will be mailed later this month. If you are one of multiple owners associated with the provided account number, you are required to select your name from the list provided. If a match is found, you will be sent an email with a link to complete your new account process. The email link will allow you to create a username and password (usernames must be unique). Once saved, you will be able to login into the web portal. If you have any questions, please contact us at customercare@rshoa.org or 281-778-2222.



# **Constable Corner**

On behalf of Constable Trever Nehls, the Fort Bend County Precinct 4 Constable's Office wants you to be safe as we prepare for the holidays. As you are beginning to shop for your loved ones, we want you to be safe. Here are some tips to help you get through the holidays:

- Try to shop during the day, but if you do shop at night, do not do it alone. Use the Buddy System.
- Only carry your driver's license or identification along with any necessary cash, checks and/or a credit card you expect to use.
   Avoid carrying unnecessary credit cards or large amounts of cash.
- Do not carry a purse or wallet, if possible. Consider bringing a security travel pouch instead.
- · Avoid parking and walking through dark locations.
- Plan your routes from your car to the store.
- Have your car keys in your hand before arriving at your car and avoid having to search for your keys while standing at your car.

- Recognize when you are rushed or distracted and stay alert to your surroundings. Thieves target distracted individuals.
- Beware of strangers approaching you for any reason. Strangers try various methods of distracting you. (Ex: a stranger offering assistance in carry your bags and packages to your car.) They do not always work alone. They work in teams to take your money or belongings.
- Look for suspicious activity and report accordingly. Be sure to report the incident while it's occurring. For emergencies call 911.

## **Tennis Court Etiquette**

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an
  adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball
  when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.

- Court #6 at The Club at Riverstone and court #9 at Riverstone Blvd are designated as walk on courts.
- Only authorized professionals are allowed to teach at both Riverstone's locations.
