# Property Maintenance Tips from the RSHOA Compliance Department

#### Power/Pressure Washing Sidewalk or Driveway

Why is it important to power wash your sidewalk and/or driveway? Over time sidewalks and driveways collect dirt and allow mold and mildew to start growing on the concrete. When this happens and if it continues without intervention, the area may become slippery and could potentially create a hazard. It also detracts from the look of our Community when dirt, stains, and mildew are easily visible from the



street. This can also be true near and around pop up drains from pools or French drains that are close to the curb. Power/Pressure washing the sidewalk and driveway areas of your property, this includes the sidewalk in front of your property and on the side if it is a corner lot, will help to maintain the look of our Community.

#### Trash/Recycle Bins

Trash and Recycle bins that are left out in public view on non-trash days is one of the top violations that the Compliance department sees throughout our Community. To help keep our Community looking its best we want to remind all residents to remove their trash/recycle bins from public view on non-trash days. This can be achieved by placing the bins in the garage or behind a wooden fence. You may also submit an ARC application to install a storage area for the Trash and Recycle bins and have it reviewed by our ARC committee. You may obtain the ARC application on our website at www.rshoa.org.

#### Lawn bags

Lawn clippings that are left in bags at the curb or end of the driveway are also considered a violation of the deed restrictions. All trash, including the lawn clippings, must be place in an appropriate container and stored out of view on non-trash days. This will help to keep our neighborhoods looking tidy.

# What the Architectural Review Committee Does for You

Are you getting ready to make an addition to your house or build a new shed or fence in your back yard? Before you break out the miter saw, make sure to get your plans approved by our association's Architectural ReviewCcommittee (ARC).

While it may seem arbitrary from an individual homeowner's standpoint, the architectural committee looks out for the entire community. Aside from stopping residents from painting pink polka dots on their houses, the committee's job is to make sure that the size and style of the project, the type of building materials being used and the overall look of the new structure adhere to the association's design requirements. Not only does this keep the community looking cohesive, it also helps to keep property values up by preventing individual structures from standing out. Of course, it's also important to note that unapproved structures might legally have to be removed at the owner's expense, so save yourself money

On behalf of Constable Trever Nehls, the Fort Bend County Precinct 4 Constable's Office, would like to encourage implementing an at home alone safety plan for your children.

Safety Tips While at Home Alone

 Provide an updated emergency contact information list containing first and



last names (no nicknames), phone numbers, and addresses of the emergency contacts. Work contact information can also be extremely helpful. Keep the list in an easily known and accessible location.

- Teach your children to contact 911 in an emergency situation first and then contact parent(s) second. In an emergency situation seconds and minutes can mean the difference between life and death.
- · Speak about not opening doors for unknown person(s) and what to do when this occurs.
- Discuss the importance of not informing unknown person(s) that there are no adults home.
- Lastly, practicing and discussing scenarios are always best to prepare for the unexpected.

Look for suspicious activity and report accordingly while occurring. For Emergencies dial 911 and for Non-Emergencies contact your area agency. Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office (281) 341-4665, Missouri City Police Department (281) 403-8700.

# DON'T FORGET YOUR RESERVATION!

*Our Fitness Center is open—with all sanitizing and social distancing protocols.* You'll need an Amenity Pass reservation on the Riverstone app, as well as your Amenity Card to get in. Download the Riverstone App on your Android or Apple phones to get started. Here are some additional reminders about temporary policies in place:

- All residents entering the facility are required to wear masks.
- Residents are required to sanitize any equipment brought from home before entering the building and again prior to leaving the facility.
- Residents must wash or sanitize hands upon entering the facility.

# SLEEP FOR OVERALL WELLNESS

*Sleep is absolutely essential to living a healthy life, and this goes far beyond building muscle or burning fat.* Sleep is the time when the body does the majority of its maintenance work, repairing the damage from the previous day and building us anew so that we can tackle the new challenges awaiting us.

#### What can we do to sleep better at night?

- Maintain a regular sleep schedule (e.g. go to bed and wake up at the same time, even on weekends).
- Make your room as dark as possible.
- Keep your room a cool 65-68 degrees Fahrenheit.
- Avoid blue light exposure 2 hours before going to bed.
- Limit stressful events during the day and avoid them at all costs in the immediate hours before bed.
- Limit caffeine intake during the day and try to end your caffeine intake 6-8 hours before bed.
- Do what you love for a living. We spend more time at work than we do at home. If you hate your job, that stress will continue to compound and ruin your ability to sleep soundly.
- Avoid alcohol in the hours before bed.
- Take a warm bath at night. When you get out of the tub, core temperature drops as your body tries to dissipate heat, allowing you to be cooler and sleep better!

### **Tennis Court Etiquette**

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.

- Court #6 at The Club at Riverstone and court #9 at Riverstone Blvd are designated as walk on courts.
- Only authorized professionals are allowed to teach at both Riverstone's locations.
