### **Check Out Your Resident Portal**

*Did you know that you have access to your HOA account through our Resident Portal?* The Resident Portal provides homeowners with convenient, real time, 24-hour access to your account where you will be able to view and update your homeowner information, view account information and make payments, view compliance violations, architectural requests, and more! You can access the portal from our website

at www.rshoa.org by clicking the Resident Account Portal tab on the top of your screen. When you are logging into the web portal for the first time, you will need to select the "Create login" link. You will then enter your account number and email address. If you do not have your Account Number, please contact us at customercare@rshoa.org. It will also be printed on the 2021 Assessment statement that will be mailed later this month. If you are one of multiple owners associated with the provided account number, you are required to select your name from the list provided. If a match is found, you will be sent an email with a link to complete your new account process. The email link will allow you to create a username and password (usernames must be unique). ### **Property Maintenance Tips**

#### from the RSHOA Compliance Department

*We understand that the season of giving and gifts is quickly approaching!* Adults and children alike may be receiving new gifts and fun additions for the holiday season. As a reminder, please note that residents should submit an ARC Modification Application for basketball goals, playsets, and other items related to the outside of the property. Modification submittals are reviewed by the Architectural Review Committee the first Wednesday of each month. Residents can download the ARC Modification Application on the residential website and email the application to ARCModification@rshoa.org.

The holidays can be a joyous time of family gatherings and cheer. From wreaths, tinsel, and colorful lights to Frosty the Snowman and Santa's reindeer, decorations are a fun and beautiful way to celebrate the season. While the Association enjoys seeing the holiday spirit being displayed as much as anyone else, we would like to send a friendly reminder to all residents to adhere the deed restrictions when decorating the exterior of your homes. Per the deed restrictions: "Customary seasonal decorations for national holidays are permitted for a maximum of twelve (12) days or thirty (30) days, in the case of Christmas, subject to the right of the Residential ARC to specify a maximum size and other guidelines for decorations". ALL holiday décor must be removed on or before January 25th.

Riverstone Compliance Department also encourages all residents to take a few minutes and look over their property for any potential Deed Restriction issue that may result in a violation.

Even during the colder months weeds and other problems may arise during this time.

- Remember to mow, weed, and edge your law as needed.
- Remove weeds from the landscaping beds and tree wells, and treat your yard as needed to control weeds.
- Remove any dirt and/or mildew from property, pressure wash driveways and sidewalks to remove dirt and/or stains and trim trees over sidewalk and roads.
- Trash/Recycle bins need to be placed out of public view on non-trash days.
- All trash must be placed in an appropriate trash container. Please do not place bags alone on the curb.

### **Constable Corner**



On behalf of Constable Trever Nehls, the Fort Bend County Precinct 4 Constable's Office, would like to encourage Crime Prevention Tips.

#### Automated Teller Machine (ATM) Safety Tips

The following crime prevention tips can help make the use of ATM's safer for everyone.

Criminals select their victims and targets, focusing on the unaware or unprepared. The attitude and demeanor you convey can have a tremendous effect on potential assailants. There are a number of things you can do to increase your personal security and reduce your risk of becoming an ATM crime victim. Walk purposefully and with confidence. Give the appearance that you are totally aware of your surroundings. Be aware of your total environment and what is going on around you. Criminals tend to avoid people who have this type of demeanor.

#### **ATM Selection Considerations**

- Do not select an ATM at the corner of a building. Corners create a blind area in close proximity to the customer's transaction. Select an ATM located near the center of a building. An ATM further from the corner reduces the element of surprise by an assailant and increases effective reaction time by the user;
- Select an ATM that is in a well-lighted location;
- Whenever possible, select an ATM that is monitored or patrolled by a security officer;
- Avoid ATM locations with large perimeter parking lots and numerous ingress and egress points.

#### **Considerations Prior to and During Transactions**

- Maintain a small supply of deposit envelopes at home, in your car or office. Prepare all transaction paperwork prior to your arrival at the ATM site. This will minimize the amount of time spent at the ATM;
- Maintain an awareness of your surroundings throughout the entire transaction. Do not become so involved with your transaction that you are not aware of changing conditions around you;
- Do not wear expensive jewelry or take other valuables to the ATM. This is an added incentive to an assailant;
- Be aware of anyone sitting in a parked car in close proximity to or at a distance from the ATM location;
- When leaving an ATM location make sure you are not being followed. If you are being followed, drive immediately to a police, sheriff or fire station, crowded area, well-lighted location or open business. Flash your lights and sound your horn to bring attention to your situation; and
- If you are involved in a confrontation and the attacker is armed with a weapon and demands your money or valuables, COMPLY.

Don't Forget! You need an Amenity Pass reservation on the Riverstone app, as well as your Amenity Card to use the Fitness Center. Download the Riverstone App on your Android or Apple phones to get started. Here are some additional reminders about temporary policies in place:

- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.
