NEW HOMEOWNERS NEEDING AMENITY CARDS

Welcome to Riverstone! To have amenity cards made for you, please email us the following:

- Completed amenity card form (found at www. rshoa.org)
- 2. Deed or closing disclosure

- Individual headshot pictures of each resident over the age of 5. Please label each photo with their name and date of birth.
- Proof of identification (State ID, Driver's License, passport, etc) for all residents over the age of 18
- 5. Anyone over the age of 18 whose name is not listed on the deed will need to provide additional proof of residence. Examples of acceptable Proof of Residency may include car insurance, utility bill, cell phone bill, etc. and must include the resident's name and current home address.

Each account will receive up to 3 adult amenity cards and at no charge. Each additional adult amenity card after the first 3 cards is \$15.00.

REPLACING A LOST AMENITY CARD

The replacement of lost Amenity Cards is available for \$15 each.

If you need a replacement Amenity Card, please complete the credit card form found on our website (www.rshoa.org) and email it to us at customercare@rshoa.org. Please also include your home address and a headshot picture labeled with your name and date of birth.

Annual Assessment Reminder

Your 2022 Annual Assessment Statements were mailed last month. As a reminder, your Assessments are due January 1, 2022 and late after January 31, 2022. Please see the financial insert in this newsletter, or visit www.rshoa.org, for payment options.

What's easiest way to make your payment? Why, the Resident Portal of course! Visit www.rshoa.org to login and make your payment electronically from your couch. E-check payments are FREE! There is a small charge for debit card payments (\$5 flat fee) and credit card

payments (3% surcharge). If you've never logged in before, you'll find your account number on your statement. (It starts with 1004) If you prefer, you may also drop your check off in the drop box in front of the HOA office.

If you have not received your statement by Wednesday, December 15th, or if you have any questions about your 2022 Annual Assessment, please contact Shannon at Finance@rshoa.org. We're here to help!

Check Out Your Resident Portal

Did you know that you have access to your HOA account through our Resident Portal? The Resident Portal provides homeowners with convenient, real time, 24-hour access to your account where you will be able to view and update your homeowner information, view account information and make payments, view compliance violations, architectural requests, and more!

You can access the portal from our website at www.rshoa.org by clicking the Resident Account Portal tab on the top of your screen. When you are logging into the web portal for the first time, you will need to select the "Create login" link. You will then enter your ac-

count number and email address. If you do not have your Account Number, please contact us at customercare@rshoa.org. It will also be printed on the 2022 Assessment statement. If you are one of multiple owners associated with the provided account number, you are required to select your name from the list provided. If a match is found, you will be sent an email with a link to complete your new account process. The email link will allow you to create a username and password (usernames must be unique). Once saved, you will be able to login into the web portal. If you have any questions, please contact us at customercare@rshoa.org or 281.778.2222.

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2022 HOA ASSESSMENTS

Upon the review and consideration by the Board of Directors, the 2022 budget has been approved and the general assessment rate set at \$1,110. Please know that this is no change from 2021, and comes after a detailed planning and review process considering both Capital, Reserve, and Operating expenses.

For the 2022 Budget, 46% of funds are allocated to the continued landscape maintenance and improvements of the Riverstone community, including common areas, parks and pools, lakes and wetlands, and their associated utilities. 13% of funds are allocated to General and Administrative costs, 5% of funds for Recreation and Fun, including fitness center and tennis court maintenance, and 5% to Compliance for enforcement of deed restrictions. Additionally, RSHOA continues to properly fund the Reserve Account to ensure funds are available to repair or replace assets of Riverstone as it becomes necessary to do so. The remaining 13% of budgeted costs reflect a \$569,804 contribution to the Reserve Fund Account and \$450,000 to the Capital Projects Fund.

As a reminder, each gated neighborhood also has a separate budget and neighborhood assessment, as required by the neighborhood supplemental addendums. That information is sent out to those neighborhoods individually with their Assessment Statement.

The Board of Directors believes this 2022 Budget is a strong, responsible budget necessary to see Riverstone into the future. 2022 Payment Information

The Association has established four ways to pay your 2022 Assessment:

- Online ePayments (eCheck or credit card) through the Resident Portal
- 2 Personal Bill Pay
- 3 Personal Check via Mail
- 4 Payment Plans

1 Online ePayments on your Resident Portal

Visit www.rshoa.org select "Resident Account Portal."
Once you have logged into the Portal system, click on the black "Pay Now" button on the left of your screen.
A pop-up screen will open with two options:
Pay with eCheck or Pay with Credit Card.

E-Check

Clicking "Pay with eCheck thru Alliance Association Bank" will expand the One-Time eCheck payment window. Enter the required information and your payment will be electronically withdrawn from your bank account and sent to our payment processing center. Please be aware that it can take up to 5 business days for eCheck payments to process and be credited to your account (although most are processed the next business day). You will receive an e-mail confirming that your payment has processed. This service is FREE and easy to use. Riverstone's Management Company ID is 7214. Your Association ID is R100. Your Account number is a 10-digit number located on the top of your payment coupon.

Credit Card Payments

Clicking "Pay with Credit Card through Alliance Association Bank" will expand the credit card payment window. We can accept Visa, Master Card, American Express or Discover. You will incur a 3% processing fee for credit cards and \$5 flat processing fee for debit cards. Please be aware that it can take up to 7 business days for Credit Card payments to process and credit to your account (although most are processed in 4-5 days). Credit card payments can only be made online. Credit card payments are not taken at the Association office.

2 Personal Bill Pay

If you opt to use your Bank's bill payment feature through your Online Banking channel, please be aware that this will be sent via a check and may take up to 7 business days to reach our lockbox, even though your bank may withdraw the funds immediately. When setting up Riverstone HOA as a vendor merchant within your Bank's Payment system, please make sure you include the following information:

Merchant/Vendor Name: Riverstone HOA Merchant/Vendor Address: P.O. Box 94104, Las Vegas, NV 89193-4104 In ALL cases, payments are posted by DATE RECEIVED, not date submitted or postmark date. Please allow ample time for your payment to reach our lockbox. Your Account number and/or our billing address may have changed from last year. Please verify your information before mailing a payment. Payments mailed to any other addresses will not be received by Riverstone and will be subject to late charges.

3 Personal Check via Mail

Personal check payments should be mailed to the Riverstone HOA lockbox at P.O. Box 94104, Las Vegas, NV 89193-4104. This address will be reflected on the assessment statement. It is very important to include your payment coupon along with your personal check so that your payment may be applied to your account.

By sending us your check, please be aware that you are authorizing Alliance Association Bank to use information on your check to make a one-time electronic debit from your account at the financial institution indicated on your check. If we cannot collect from your electronic payment, we will issue a draft against your account. If you do not have sufficient funds in your account, your financial institution may debit a fee from your account and Riverstone HOA will charge you a \$50 NSF fee and your payment will be considered late.

4 Payment Plans

In order to provide a choice of easy, convenient methods of paying your 2022 assessments, the following payment plans have been approved. Review each plan carefully and select the one best suited for you.

Option 1

You may pay your 2022 assessment in one or more payments before January 31, 2022. There is no handling fee associated with this option. All Assessment balances after January 31, 2022 will accrue interest and late charges.

Option 2

If you need more time to pay, Payment Plan options of up to 6 months are available. Monthly administrative fees will apply. Please email Finance@rshoa.org for more information.

Option 3

For those Assessments that become delinquent on the 1st day of February, the entire Assessment balance along with interest and administrative costs shall then be due and payable in three (3) payments. The due dates for the Payment Plan will be February 28th, March 31st, and April 30th. If you need more time to pay, please contact us.

The Compliance Department would like to provide helpful tips to keep our community looking its best and to be a good neighbor.

Parking—We would like to remind residents to not park in front of fire hydrants as this can possibly impact fire departments in the course of the duties.

Trim Trees—Please remember to trim trees above roadways and sidewalks.

Lawns—Maintain yards and treat for weeds to keep a healthy and neat lawn.

ARC Modifications—Please remember to submit for any modification to either the front or back of your yard. This includes any painting or staining.

Free Gym Walkthrough

MUSCLE OF THE MONTH-Forearm

The forearm can be brought closer to the upper arm (flexed) and brought away from the upper arm (extended) due to movement at the elbow. The forearm can also be rotated so that the palm of the hand rotates inwards (pronated) and rotated back so that the palm rotates outwards (supinated) due to movement at the elbow and the distal radioulnar joint.

Exercises for Forearms: Farmer's Walks, Heavy Deadlifts, Wrist Rollers, Seated Reverse Wrist Curl, Seated Wrist Curls, Dead Hangs, Grip Crushes

Tennis Court Etiquette

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an
 adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball
 when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.

Recently there has been an increase of tennis lessons at Riverstone by unauthorized tennis pros. Please keep in mind that HOA rules prohibits the teaching of tennis lessons by unauthorized persons.




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






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
















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
