

A Note from the Compliance Dept

Compliance Reminder About Parking in our Community

The Riverstone HOA does have a parking policy in place which outlines our parking rules within the Community. Below are some highlights from this policy.

Qualified Vehicles is defined as—passenger automobiles, passenger vans, motorcycles, or pick-up trucks that are in working order, current on vehicle tags, and are in regular use. Any vehicle that does not meet these requirements is considered to be a stored vehicle and must be completely concealed from public view.

Vehicles may not be parked in the Street for more than 7 consecutive days. The intent of this provision is to keep the Streets clear and allow for the unobstructed flow of traffic.



No vehicles may be parked so as to obstruct or block a sidewalk, parked either wholly or partially on a curb, or be parked on a grassy area.

No vehicle may be parked in such a way as to inhibit or adversely affect ingress/egress from a driveway on a daily basis

Commercial vehicles, including but not limited to associated machinery, trailers or equipment in use for the construction, repair or maintenance of a Residence, Lot, or Common Area may be temporarily parked in the immediate vicinity of such Residence, Lot or Common Area, but only for the time necessary for such purpose.

A recreational vehicle with not more than two axles may be temporarily parked in front of a Lot or on the driveway of a Lot for up to forty-eight (48) hours for loading and unloading only.

As a reminder to help keep streets clear and allow for the unobstructed flow of traffic, the Association's Board of Directors previously adopted parking rules and regulations. The policy may viewed in its entirety by visiting the HOA website at www.rshoa.org > Resource Center > RSHOA Policies & Guidelines > Parking Rules and Regulations. Some highlights include:

Non-Gated Neighborhoods

- Registered, operational, non-commercial vehicles may not be parked in the street for more than seven (7) consecutive days.
 *It is NOT the intent of this provision to permit the regular use of streets as parking areas, and the Association will have the sole discretion in determining whether a vehicle violates the provision.
- Parked vehicles may not obstruct sidewalks or be parked on a curb or grassy area.
- Parked vehicles may not adversely affect ingress/egress from a driveway on a daily basis.
- Commercial vehicles may be parked temporarily for the purpose of providing a service, making a delivery, or picking up materials, but only for the time necessary for such purpose.
- Recreational vehicles (ex. campers, golf carts, boats, etc.) may not be stored on residential lots for more than forty-eight (48) hours unless written request is received and approved by the HOA.
 Recreational vehicles may be stored on residential lots for longer periods provided they are completely concealed from public view inside a garage or enclosure approved by the HOA.

Gated Neighborhoods

- Parking on roads and alleyways owned by the HOA is prohibited.
 Vehicles left on HOA property for more than 24 hours may be towed at owner's expense with no prior notice.
- Additional parking restrictions may be set forth in a neighborhood's supplemental declarations.

RIVERSTONE WETLANDS

An Important Part of the Community









Did you ever wonder why there are plants growing in some of the lakes around Riverstone? There are approximately 25 acres of manmade wetland areas within the community. When Riverstone was beginning development, impacts to special aquatic sites, e.g. existing wetlands, were unavoidable. As a result, Riverstone was required to obtain a permit from the United States Army Corps of Engineers (US-ACE) by stating impacts and including mitigation of resources for the aquatic ecosystem in this area.

New wetland areas were created within the lakes that were constructed throughout the Riverstone community. These new wetland plants, while fulfilling the mitigation component of the USACE permit, also provide valuable ecosystem services to the area. These services include, but are not limited to: fish habitat, food for wildlife, water quality enhancement, biodiversity, and nutrient cycling.

Maintenance activity within the wetlands is limited in order to comply with federal laws. Furthermore, since Riverstone's wetlands are intended to be natural systems, they are not manicured to the same aesthetic standards as a resident's lawn or some of the other common areas. While some residents may consider the wetlands unsightly during portions of the year, these areas are providing valuable function to the environment.



Don't Forget! You need an Amenity Pass reservation on the Riverstone app, as well as your Amenity Card to use the Fitness Center. Download the Riverstone App on your Android or Apple phones to get started. Here are some additional reminders about temporary policies in place:

- All residents entering the facility are required to wear masks.

Tennis Court Etiquette

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- . When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an
 adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball
 when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.

Unauthorized Tennis Lessons

Recently there has been an increase of tennis lessons at Riverstone by unauthorized tennis pros. Please keep in mind that HOA rules prohibits the teaching of tennis lessons by unauthorized persons.

Tennis Court Reminders

- Court #6 at The Club at Riverstone and court #9 at Riverstone Blvd are designated as walk on courts.
- Only authorized professionals are allowed to teach at both Riverstone's locations.
- Please remember all tennis court reservations are now available through the Riverstone app only.

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
