- 3. Individual headshot pictures of each resident over the age of 5. Please label each photo with their name and date of birth.
- 4. Proof of identification (State ID, Driver's License, passport, etc) for all residents over the age of 18.
- 5. Anyone over the age of 18 whose name is not listed on the deed will need to provide additional proof of residence. Examples of acceptable Proof of Residency may include car insurance, utility bill, cell phone bill, etc. and must include the resident's name and current home address.

Each account will receive up to 3 adult amenity cards and at no charge. Each additional adult amenity card after the first 3 cards is \$15.00.

REPLACING A LOST AMENITY CARD

The replacement of lost Amenity Cards is available for \$15 each.


Calling All Volunteers

Gated Neighborhood Committee(s)—Responsible for recommending service levels and providing input on reserve projects for their respective Gated Neighborhood (such as gate operations, landscaping, camera systems, etc.). They also provide input on annual Gated Neighborhood Assessment levels and annual budgets.

Riverstone Business Spotlight

A child's first visit to the dentist should be fun—not scary. That's the goal of Dr. Mitra Pandya and the staff at Riverstone Pediatric Dentistry.



College of Dentistry.

"After graduating from dental school, all dentists are consid-

ered general or family dentists," Dr. Pandya said. "A pediatric dentist completes an additional two to three years of training following dental school to specialize in the care of children. We care for little ones from birth all the way through adolescence, including children with special needs."

During that two-year program she also earned a master's degree in oral sciences for her research on the management of traumatic dental injuries in children. In 2011, she became a Diplomate of the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry. In 2016, she opened Riverstone Pediatric Dentistry.

"Our primary focus is to provide kind, compassionate and expert care to our patients and their families," Dr. Pandya said. "We strongly believe in prevention and education because good oral health is a big part of a child's overall health."

Dr. Pandya said that parents should choose a pediatric dentist for the same reason they choose a pediatrician for their children.

"We are highly skilled and trained experts in the growth and development of children," she said.

Her colorful office is designed to make a visit to the dentist fun and comfortable-a visit the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry recommends children have by their first birthday.





"The purpose of this visit is to educate parents on proper oral hygiene, nutrition and oral habits," she said. "We assess the growth and development of your baby and answer any questions you may have."

That education includes letting parents know that tooth decay is one of the most common diseases in children.


"Many children don't lose all of their baby teeth until age 12, so preventing decay or treating it early is crucial," Dr. Pandya said. "Additionally, establishing healthy habits early in life and having routine preventive care decreases the risk for decay in permanent teeth."

What makes Riverstone Pediatric Dentistry unique is the undivided attention Dr. Pandya and her staff give to their young patients.

"From the moment they are greeted by our friendly and loving team, to when they walk out with a smile and a prize, each child is treated like our own," she said. "It's always heartwarming when our patients and their families tell us they love visiting us, and we've had a few that are set on becoming dentists themselves when they grow up."

Fort Bend County Nonprofit Spotlight

When children are removed from their homes because of abuse or neglect, they often need new clothes, shoes, diapers and other items. In the past, caseworkers often used their own money to get these muchneeded items. Today, they can get them from the Fort Bend Rainbow Room (FBRR).

The non-profit serves children and adults with open cases of abuse and/or neglect

who have been referred to the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services.

"Many of these cases are due to economic challenges," said Tonya Lewis, Fort Bend Rainbow Room Executive Director. "Supplies provided to our families include diapers, formula, clothes, shoes, socks, underwear, hygiene items, cleaning supplies, school supplies, beds and car seats."



First Lady Laura Bush helped start the original Rainbow Room in Dallas County. Others quickly followed. Fort Bend Rainbow Room has been around since 1998 with the philosophy of providing new items instead of used ones.

"New items help build self-esteem," Lewis said. "For some of the children we serve, this is their first time receiving new items. And for many children, the new items that they are receiving will be theirs and not passed down from an older sibling or have to be shared. We've had kids sharing toothbrushes."

Last year, FBRR served 2,400 children, but Lewis said the need has increased.

"The number of cases being assigned to investigations increased 41 percent from the previous year," she said.

The organization has seen an increase in the need for beds and linens as well cleaning supplies—especially hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes. Paper products such as toilet paper and towels are

"Through our Back to School Project children receive new clothes, shoes, backpacks and supplies which helps them attend school in a manner similar to their peers," Lewis said. "With generational cycles of neglect due to economic hardships, we hope by providing the proper tools for school. our clients will be able to break this cycle.

also needed. Other items on their wish list include diaper bags, athletic shoes, snacks, clothes, books, toys and school supplies.

An important project for Fort Bend Rainbow Room is the Annual Back to School Project which helps children return to school with new supplies.



In addition to donations, FBRR is always in need of volunteers.

"Overall, we have approximately 250 volunteer opportunities a year," Lewis said. "Our annual golf tournament—which is on April 24th at Pecan Grove Country Club—will require the support of approximately 25 volunteers for that day alone."

Fort Bend Rainbow Room is also in need of volunteers for the annual fall luncheon as well as the Back to School Project and the Christmas Project. Board of Directors positions are also available.

"Volunteer opportunities are usually posted on our website through either events or projects as the schedules are confirmed," Lewis said.

In the end, it is communities like Riverstone that contribute to the success of FBRR.

"With the support of the community, we are able to make our mission of providing for Fort Bend County's children and adults in crisis a success," Lewis said. "As the need continues to increase, we need to continue to grow new partnerships to make meeting this demand possible. We don't receive state or federal funding, so it's truly the support of our community that makes it work."

Tennis Court Etiquette

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.











