- 4. Proof of identification (State ID, Driver's License, passport, etc) for all residents over the age of 18.
- 5. Anyone over the age of 18 whose name is not listed on the deed will need to provide additional proof of residence. Examples of acceptable Proof of Residency may include car insurance, utility bill, cell phone bill, etc. and must include the resident's name and current home address.

Each account will receive up to 3 adult amenity cards and at no charge. Each additional adult amenity card after the first 3 cards is \$15.00.



Gate Tips From Andrew

- When entering a neighborhood, drive close to the toll tag reader. If you are not sure where they are located, please call the HOA office.
- Do not bump the gates to try to get them to open. This will damage the gates and cause them not to function properly.
- Do not allow children to climb or hang on gates and report any misconduct immediately. Please provide as much information as possible such as date, time, and license plate info.



 Finally, the easiest way to report gate issues is on the LUKE app. Residents may also report gate issues by emailing the Operations Team at operations@riverstone.com or by calling the HOA office at 281.778.2222. "After completing my service," he said. Conservation and Development Alligators in Riverstone

For centuries, alligators have inhabited Texas' marshes, swamps, rivers, ponds, and lakes. They are an essential part of Texas's natural history and integral to freshwater ecosystems.

As Riverstone continues to develop, there exists the potential for increased interactions between people and alligators. Once endangered, alligators were taken off the endangered species list in 1978. However, they are still protected by law. Alligators are found in 10 different states, and here in Texas, they are found in 120 of 254 counties, including Fort Bend.

A better understanding of alligators and their behavior will help ensure that residents and alligators can continue to coexist. Alligators naturally shy away from humans and prefer isolated areas away from people. In the spring and summer, alligators are moving to breed and find new habitats. Most of the alligators seen moving around are the smaller ones pushed out of their normal habitat by larger alligators. Usually, these smaller alligators will move further on in a week or two. Our most active months here in Riverstone are April through July.

Several alligators have been spotted recently in Riverstone Lakes. Still, at this time, they have not exhibited behavior that would be defined as a "nuisance" by the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD).

Alligators are native to the area and can be found in the lakes and bayous around the community. Riverstone Association and LID 15 follow the guidelines and regulations set by TPWD for trapping and relocating alligators.

If You See an Alligator

Many residents will live in close proximity to these native reptiles with no confrontations; however, there are occasions when certain alligators become a "nuisance" and must be



handled by the proper authorities. The current legal definition of a nuisance alligator is "an alligator that is depredating (killing livestock or pets) or a threat to human health and safety." TPWD is the only authority that can deem an alligator a nuisance because of its protected status. Riverstone Association and LID 15 rely on TWPD to perform any removals.

Alligators have a natural fear of humans and usually retreat when approached by people; however, the following are instances in which local authorities should be notified:

- If you see an alligator in the roadway;
- If you see an alligator being antagonized or fed;
- If an alligator is repeatedly following boats, canoes, or other watercraft and/or maintains a close distance without submersing; or
- If you walk near the water and an alligator comes straight toward you, especially if it comes out of the water.

Fort Bend County Nonprofit Spotlight





Adults and children need an outlet for their creativity. The Sugar Land Art Center & Gallery fulfills that need, offering classes, affordable art and Lego camps, studios for artists to create and a gallery to showcase their work.

Local artists Marilyn Dickey and Kip Dornhorst co-founded the art center in 2005. The mission, said Bobbi Templin, Executive Director of Sugar Land Art Center & Gallery, is to provide an inspiring environment for the creative individual—including children and senior citizens—through art lessons, art education, creative structured Lego camps, working studio space, a gallery and fellowship. Overall, the center desires to promote a positive awareness of the arts.

"Art is alive and well in Sugar Land, Texas," Templin said. "We are a 501c3 non-profit organization. Just think about it, without art how much of our history would be lost?

The location in Sugar Land has four classrooms. The center hosts classes, camps, bridal showers, birthday parties, private lessons, workshops and more. There are also 21 studios for artists. Currently, all are leased and there is a waiting list. The gallery showcases the work of Texas artists mostly from Fort Bend County.

Classes cater to both adults and children. In addition to drawing, painting, sketching and sculpting classes, the center also offers music and Lego classes. Templin said that art is important for children, especially now that many schools have less emphasis on the arts.

"Art helps improve fine and gross motor skills, teaches children to be more aware of themselves and others, teaches focus and perseverance and helps children express their emotions in a positive way," she said. "Art also has the ability to help you reach out to your potential by expressing yourself through creative ideas."

The nonprofit offers affordable summer camps for children ages 5 to 14. Art and Lego camps for children make the center special, Templin said. Spring, summer, pumpkin painting and winter camps are available. The summer camps serve approximately 1,000 children annually.

"We have Lego and art camps morning and afternoon," she said. "All Legos are furnished by the center for different activities.

We have art camps which are theme-driven. Once the theme is selected, the kids are divided by ages. They will paint a 16x20 canvas, sculpture, watercolor, oil pastels, drawing and sketching." On the last day of camps, students will bring all their projects home to display and enjoy.

Templin said that the camps are very affordable so everyone can enjoy the arts. There is a scholarship program for families who cannot afford to pay.

A registered and approved 501c3, Sugar Land Art Center & Gallery is totally supported by the money it generates through the classes and rentals of its classrooms.

They do need "volunteers" to help teachers and the children with the art and Lego camps.

When it comes to the center, the benefits are enormous.



"Art classes expose students to art from all over the world, which helps them understand our shared humanity," Templin said. "Studying the history of ancient Romans, Egyptians, Christians, etc. would be very difficult if not highlighted by the art that was left behind helping us to understand our past."

Sugar Land Art Center Is located at 104 Industrial Blvd, Ste. Q in Sugar Land. Summer camps began on May 30 and run from 9 a.m. to noon and 1 to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday through the week of August 7.

Tennis Court Etiquette

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an
 adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball
 when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.

Tennis Court Reminders

- Court #6 at The Club at Riverstone and court #9 at Riverstone Blvd are designated as walk
 on courts. They are available for walk-on play during tennis court hours. Please be mindful
 when using the courts for walk-on play and limit your time to a maximum of 2 hours.

- Remember that court reservations will be forfeited after 15 minutes of not showing up for scheduled start time.




