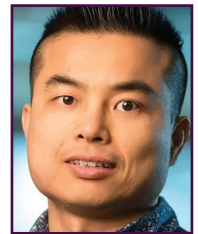

PACKING UP HOLIDAY CHEER

A Fresh Start for the New Year

As the holiday season comes to a close, it's time to start packing away the festive cheer! Remember to take down your holiday lights and decorations. This ensures a tidy and welcoming environment for the new year, while also adhering to community guidelines. Let's embrace a fresh start as we transition into a new season!

COMPLIANCE REMINDERS

Riverstone Compliance Department encourages all residents to take a few minutes and look over their property for any potential deed restriction issue that may result in a violation. Here are some helpful reminders:

- Any landscape modifications or additions to the front or rear yard require approval from the MSC.
- Please trim trees over the sidewalk and street so that it does not impact pedestrians and vehicles or block street signs.
- Remember to remove weeds from your landscaping beds and tree wells and to treat your lawn for weeds.
- Keep your trash and recycle bin out of public view on non-trash days. This includes any trash bags.
- Remove trees stakes if they are over 1 year old.
- Please do not park vehicles to block the sidewalk.
- Remove any dirt and/or mildew on the outside of the house.
- Portable basketball goals are not permitted in the front yard. They are permitted in the backyard of non-view lots but must receive MSC approval.
- Please pick up after your pets.

January–February—Optimal time to replace or plant new trees and/or landscaping. Use preemergent weed control if needed. Treat for fire ants. Fertilize with slow-release product as needed.

TOPPING TREES

Topping can remove 50 to 100 percent of a tree's leaf-bearing crown. Leaves are the food factories of a tree. Removing them can temporarily starve a tree and trigger various survival mechanisms.

- **Leads to Decay** Correct pruning cuts are made just beyond the branch collar at the point of attachment. However, cuts made along a limb between lateral branches create stubs with wounds that the tree may be unable to close. Causing the exposed wood tissues to begin to decay.
- **Makes Trees Ugly** The natural branching structure of a tree is a biological wonder. Topping removes the ends of the branches, often leaving ugly stubs. Topping destroys the natural form of a tree.
- **It's Expensive** Topping can lead to increased maintenance costs, Reduced property value, and increased liability potential.
- **Alternatives to Topping** Small branches should be removed back to their point of origin. If a larger limb must be shortened, it should be pruned back to a lateral branch large enough (at least one-third the diameter of the limb being removed) to assume the terminal role. This branch reduction method helps preserve the tree's natural form.

APPLY BEFORE YOU MODIFY

Did Santa bring a new basketball goal or playset? Or do you want to add to your house, or build a new shed, or fence in your backyard?

Before you break out the miter saw, make sure you get your plans approved by Riverstone Homeowners Association's Modification Sub Committee. While it may seem arbitrary from an individual homeowners' standpoint, the Modification Sub Committee (MSC) looks out for the entire community. Aside from stopping residents from painting pink polka dots on their houses, the committee's job is to make sure that the size and style of the project, the type of building materials being used, and the overall look of the new structure adhere to the Association's design requirements. Not only does this keep the community looking cohesive, it also helps to keep property values up by preventing individual structures from standing out. It's also important to note that unapproved modifications might legally have to be removed at the owner's expense, so save yourself money and headaches by getting it approved first! Modification application forms can be found online at www.riverstone.com > Compliance Department and should be submitted to the HOA office. Please note all modifications must go through an approval process and that the Association staff will NOT give verbal approval of any modifications. Zip Line Seat Replacement–In Progress

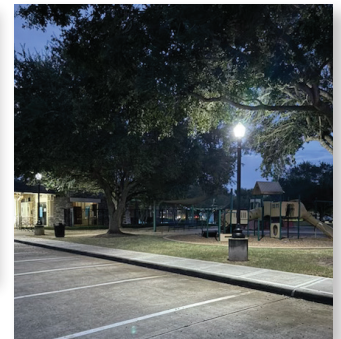
The popular community zip line is getting some love, too! Replacement seat is on the way, and as soon as it arrives, the seat will be installed so residents can enjoy the amenity once again.

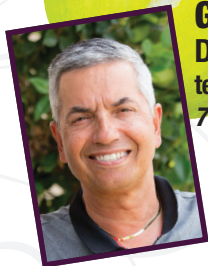

Tennis Court Etiquette

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.

Tennis Court Reminders

- Please remember all tennis court reservations are now available through the Riverstone app only.
- Remember that court reservations will be forfeited after 15 minutes of not showing up for scheduled start time.
- Tennis courts are for the use of tennis or pickleball play only. Any other sports or equipment are strictly prohibited. For more information refer to rule #4 at the Resource Center under Community Info.
- Parking for use of Tennis Courts 9 & 10 is at the Riverstone Blvd Recreation Center. Please refrain from parking within the Parkside neighborhood.

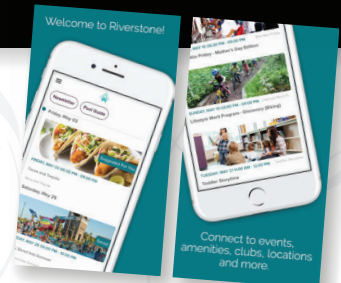
