RIVERSTONE HOA BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION RESULTS

We are thrilled to share the results of the recent election for the Riverstone Homeowners Association Board of Directors. Your active participation, with five dedicated residents vying for two open positions and the community coming together to cast 878 votes, truly demonstrates the strength of our community.

The primary role of the Board, with assistance from HOA staff, is to oversee the business of the association and plan for the future. This includes, among other things, approving annual budgets, developing policies, adopting resolutions, awarding contracts for services, approving capital expenditures, hearing homeowners' appeals on deed restriction violation issues, making decisions involving collection and legal matters, and guiding our staff. Board members are entrusted to make significant decisions that affect the greater good of the community in all respects.

We are pleased to announce that candidates Alpana Patel and Feiyu Liu have been elected to serve on the 2026 Riverstone Board of Directors—Congratulations!

The elected Directors, Alpana Patel, with 267 votes, and Feiyu Liu, with 214 votes, will serve a term of 3 years. The election was facilitated and certified by Election Trust, a third-party election company. The new Board of Directors Candidates officially begin their term on January 1, 2026.



BUSINESS SPOTLIGHT

Since its founding in 1991, The Honor Roll School (THRS) has been dedicated to cultivating a love of learning through a challenging educational program within a nurturing environment. With a preschool campus in Riverstone and a K-8 school in Sugar Land, the school is a place where children can thrive while being encouraged to explore their unique potential.

Each campus is designed to meet the specific needs of students at different stages of their academic journey. The Riverstone campus serves children from 12 months to 5 years old and provides a solid foundation for early learning.

The Sugar Land campus offers an advanced and dynamic program that supports well-rounded growth. Together, these two campuses reflect THRS's commitment to providing a seamless educational experience for students from early childhood through middle school.

"The Honor Roll School is a private, non-sectarian, co-educational day school in Sugar Land that provides an enriched, one-year advanced and highly challenging education for all of our students," said Shazia Qazi, Principal of The Honor Roll School in Riverstone. "We are constantly invested in professional development and curriculum to ensure that THRS meets the highest standards for early childhood through eighth grade education."

The Honor Roll School takes pride in its experienced and dedicated teachers and staff, with 86 staff members at the Sugar Land campus and 14 at the Riverstone campus. One of the hallmarks of THRS is the long tenure of its educators, with 30 percent of the faculty having been with the school for more than 15 years and 75 percent for more than 10 years. Teachers are given the autonomy to teach to learn rather than teaching to a test.

The Riverstone campus has the capacity to accommodate up to 240 students and provides a solid foundation for early learning.

"Our Links to Learning preschool curriculum helps children grow in many areas such as literacy, math, art, science, and social skills," Qazi said. "Each skill builds on the one before as children learn and grow."



Once students are older, they can move on to the Sugar Land campus, which can serve up to 650 students.

"For elementary and middle school, our program combines strong academics with innovative approaches to learning, creating a space where students succeed and feel excited to explore new things," Qazi said.

A unique aspect of the school is that all students, from toddlers through eighth grade, participate in school-wide community service projects throughout the year.

The school has no high school campus, but Qazi said students receive a well-rounded academic program that, in multiple dimensions, prepares its students well for the transition to high school.

"Between rigorous academics, student-centered learning, technology integration, social-emotional development, and a supportive environment, it covers many of the foundations that are important for success in high school," she said.

The curriculum is advanced by one year, with students earning up to six high school credits by the end of 8th grade.

The school serves students from around the world, with more than 40 countries represented by the student body. Admissions are rolling with students able to enroll throughout the academic year, pending availability at each program level. Admissions assessments are in place for students 4 years old to 8th grade.

Alex May, a proud member of the Class of 2017, said the school holds a special place in his heart.

"From the moment I walked through its halls as a bright-eyed pre-K student, I was immersed in an environment filled with love, encouragement, and support," he said. "It was more than just a school; it was a second home where every day felt like an opportunity to learn, grow, and build lasting connections."


- **Specific:** Make goals clear and defined. Instead of “I want to get in shape,” try “I want to lose 5 pounds.”

Tennis Court Etiquette

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.

Tennis Court Reminders

- Please remember all tennis court reservations are now available through the Riverstone app only.
- Remember that court reservations will be forfeited after 15 minutes of not showing up for scheduled start time.
- Tennis courts are for the use of tennis or pickleball play only. Any other sports or equipment are strictly prohibited. For more information refer to rule #4 at the Resource Center under Community Info.
- Parking for use of Tennis Courts 9 & 10 is at the Riverstone Blvd Recreation Center. Please refrain from parking within the Parkside neighborhood.

Unauthorized Tennis Lessons
