UNDERSTANDING THE ROLE OF THE RIVERSTONE HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION IN COMMUNITY SAFETY

As residents of the Riverstone community, it's crucial to be informed about the support systems designed to maintain a safe and pleasant living environment. A key component of this is understanding the role of the Riverstone Homeowners Association (HOA) in relation to law enforcement and safety issues.

While the HOA is dedicated to fostering a sense of community and ensuring our neighborhood remains inviting, it's important to clarify that we do not handle specific law enforcement matters. These issues include, but are not limited to:

- Mail theft
- Package theft
- Speeding
- Parking violations
- School drop-off zones
- School traffic procedures

The HOA strives to provide residents with information regarding the appropriate entities to contact. Contact information for these entities can be found on our website in the Resource Center, in the Resident Welcome Packet, and in the "Community Information" section of the resident newsletter. If you have questions regarding who to contact about these issues, the HOA is happy to point you in the right direction. However, please be aware that we do not have any role in enforcing such issues.

The responsibility for addressing specific law enforcement problems lies with local law enforcement agencies.

Safety and Reporting Guidelines

Riverstone is home to native alligators that inhabit our lakes and bayous, and most residents coexist safely with these fascinating reptiles. However, it's important to be vigilant, as there are instances where alligators may exhibit concerning behaviors such as:

- Crossing roadways
- Following watercraft
- Approaching humans

If you observe any of these behaviors, please report them to LID 15 through their contact page at <http://www.fblid15.com/contact-us>. Your report will be forwarded to the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department, the only authority authorized to manage nuisance alligators because of their protected status.

Keep in mind that while we appreciate your awareness, Riverstone HOA does not have the authority to remove these animals or enforce their removal.

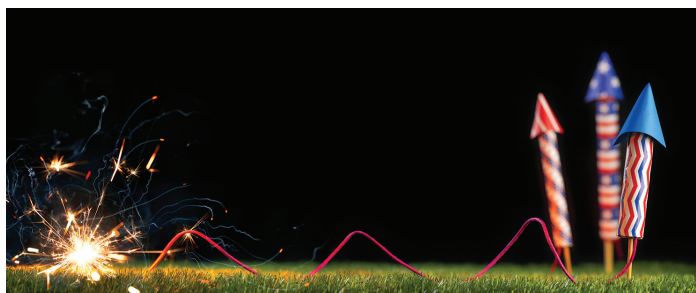

Fireworks in Riverstone

As a reminder to all residents, the use of fireworks in Riverstone is strictly prohibited under the HOA's deed restrictions. This includes all types of fireworks and applies to all areas within the neighborhood, including driveways, streets, and common areas. These restrictions are in place to preserve the quality of life for all homeowners by minimizing loud disruptions, potential property damage, and negative impacts on pets and individuals sensitive to noise. Violations of the fireworks restriction may result in enforcement actions under the deed restriction.

Tennis Court Etiquette

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.

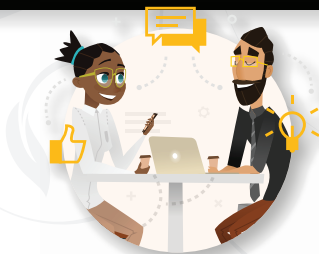

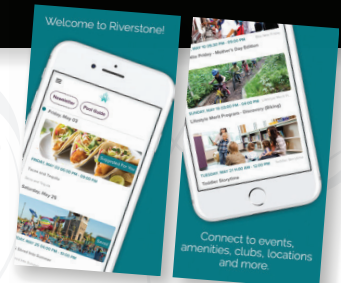
