

CARING FOR YOUR YARD AFTER A FREEZE & PREPARING FOR SPRING

From Your HOA Operations Team

Winter freezes can be tough on Texas landscapes. Even brief periods of freezing temperatures can damage grass, shrubs, flowers, and irrigation systems. The good news is that with a little patience and proper care, most yards recover well and can be set up for a strong, healthy spring season. Below are a few helpful tips for residents as we transition out of winter.

Signs of Freeze Damage to Watch For

- Brown or blackened leaves on shrubs and flowers
- Split bark or peeling on trees
- Mushy stems on annuals or tropical plants
- Patchy or straw-colored turf in lawns



Many plants will recover on their own, so avoid removing them too quickly unless they are clearly dead and brittle with no signs of green growth after several weeks.

Preparing Your Yard for Spring

1. Light Pruning and Shaping

When new growth appears, trim away dead or damaged branches. This encourages healthy regrowth and improves the overall appearance of shrubs and hedges.

2. Fertilize at the Right Time

Apply a balanced, slow-release fertilizer once temperatures consistently warm and grass begins actively growing. Fertilizing too early can stress plants or encourage premature growth.

3. Refresh Mulch and Beds

Adding a fresh layer of mulch (about 2–3 inches) helps retain moisture, regulate soil temperature, and reduce weeds. Be careful not to pile mulch directly against plant stems or tree trunks.

4. Lawn Care Basics

- Rake lightly to remove dead grass or thatch
- Overseed thin areas if needed
- Begin mowing only when the grass is actively growing and dry

5. Evaluate Planting Plans

Spring is an excellent time to replace annual flowers or add hardy, drought-tolerant plants that perform well in our region, zone 9. Consider native or freeze-resistant varieties for long-term success.

A Friendly Reminder

Seasonal weather is unpredictable, and occasional freezes are part of our climate. With thoughtful care and a little patience, most landscapes recover beautifully. Taking small steps now helps ensure greener lawns, healthier plants, and a vibrant community appearance as we move into spring.




STAY CONNECTED WITH THE LUKE APP!

Helpful Lawn Maintenance Tips:

March–October—Mowing season begins. Lawns may need to be mowed every 7-to 10 days. Weed landscaping beds and expansion joints on sidewalk and driveways.

April–October—Shrubs and other landscaping should be kept trimmed and shaped at all times. Landscaping and trees should be trimmed to not obstruct walkways, traffic in road, street signs, or address plaque.

July–October—Treat for chinch bugs as needed. Apply fungicide as needed to control diseases.

- Each family member ages five and up must get a photo amenity card. Each household will receive three adult amenity cards at no cost (Aged 14 and up). Each additional card is \$15.
- Tenants leasing a home in Riverstone may purchase amenity cards for \$15 each. Please bring or email us a copy of your ID and current lease.
- Lost amenity cards may be replaced for \$15 each. Credit Card, Check, Money Order or Cashier's Checks ONLY. No cash will be accepted.

Tennis Court Etiquette

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.

Tennis Court Reminders

- Please remember all tennis court reservations are now available through the Riverstone app only.
- Remember that court reservations will be forfeited after 15 minutes of not showing up for scheduled start time.
- Tennis courts are for the use of tennis or pickleball play only. Any other sports or equipment are strictly prohibited. For more information refer to rule #4 at the Resource Center under Community Info.
- Parking for use of Tennis Courts 9 & 10 is at the Riverstone Blvd Recreation Center. Please refrain from parking within the Parkside neighborhood.


