## UNDERSTANDING TREE SPROUTS AFTER TOPPING *What Homeowners Should Know*

*Tree care plays a crucial role in maintaining the beauty of our community.* One issue that can arise is the appearance of fast-growing shoots—commonly known as sprouts—after a tree has been heavily pruned or “topped.” The Riverstone Compliance Department would like to provide some important information on what these sprouts are, why they occur, and how they relate to HOA landscaping standards.

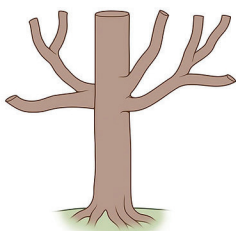
### WHAT ARE TREE SPROUTS?



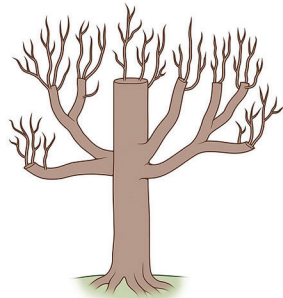
When a tree is topped, which means large portions of its canopy are removed, it reacts by producing clusters of rapid new growth from dormant buds beneath the bark. These are often referred to as water sprouts or epicormic shoots.

While this regrowth may seem like recovery, it actually indicates that the tree is under stress. These sprouts:

- Grow very quickly, often several feet in a single season.
- Form dense, crowded clusters at cut points.
- Attach weakly to the tree, making them more likely to break.
- Create an uneven and unnatural appearance.

### WHY SPROUTS MATTER IN HOA COMMUNITIES

Although HOA guidelines may not specifically mention “sprouts,” they generally address the issues associated with them. Here’s how:

#### 1. Appearance and Curb Appeal

Our community standards emphasize well-maintained, natural-looking landscapes. Dense clusters of sprouts can make trees appear overgrown or poorly maintained, potentially leading to notices regarding appearance.

#### 2. Limb Concerns

Because sprouts are weakly attached, they can easily break off—especially during storms or high winds. This could pose a risk to people, vehicles, and property.

#### 3. Tree Health

Topping is not considered a best practice in tree care. Excessive sprouting may indicate improper pruning, placing the tree under stress and potentially leading to long-term decline.

#### 4. Ongoing Maintenance Responsibility

Homeowners are responsible for maintaining trees in a safe and attractive condition. This includes managing excessive sprout growth to ensure that trees remain structurally sound and visually appealing.

### HOW TO PROPERLY MANAGE SPROUTS

If your tree has been topped, it is important to note that it will likely need to be replaced in accordance with Riverstone’s deed restrictions. This highlights the need to take extra care not to top your trees. Ensuring their health and appearance over time is essential, and avoiding topping is a crucial step in maintaining compliance and enhancing the longevity of your trees.

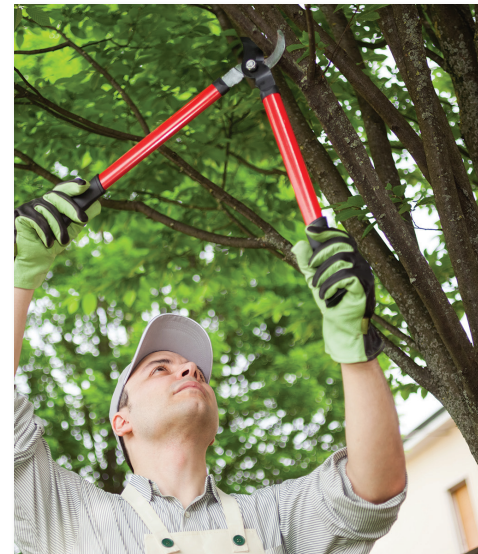
### A BETTER APPROACH MOVING FORWARD

To avoid excessive sprouting in the future, it’s best to follow proper pruning practices rather than topping. Thoughtful, selective trimming helps preserve the tree’s natural structure, improves safety, and aligns with community standards.

## HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS TIPS

### *from the Operations Department*

As hurricane season approaches, it's a good idea to take some steps to prepare yourself and your property. Here are a few tips from the Riverstone Operations Department to help you get ready:

#### GENERATORS

If you are considering adding a standby generator to your home, be sure to submit a modification application. This does not apply to portable generators. Modification application forms can be found online at [www.riverstone.com](http://www.riverstone.com) under the Compliance Department. Please submit completed forms to the HOA office. Any questions can be directed to Erica Aguirre, Compliance Administrative Assistant, at [ericaa@riverstone.com](mailto:ericaa@riverstone.com) or by calling 281.778.2222.

#### FENCE & ROOF REPAIRS

If your fence is damaged during a hurricane, you can replace it using the same materials without prior approval from the HOA. This allows for quicker repairs and helps restore your property

promptly. Similarly, necessary roof repairs can be made with the same materials, and no approval is required.

#### SECURE YOUR TRASH BINS

To prevent debris and litter from scattering, make sure to bring your trash bins inside or secure them in a sheltered area during storms.

#### REMOVE DEAD TREES OR TREE BRANCHES

Removing any dead tree branches or trees will help to reduce potential damage to your property during high winds from a storm.

#### ANCHOR TRAMPOLINES

If you have a trampoline, it's crucial to anchor it down. Strong winds can easily lift unanchored trampolines, turning them into dangerous projectiles.

Taking these steps can help mitigate the risks associated with hurricanes and ensure that you and your property remain prepared!

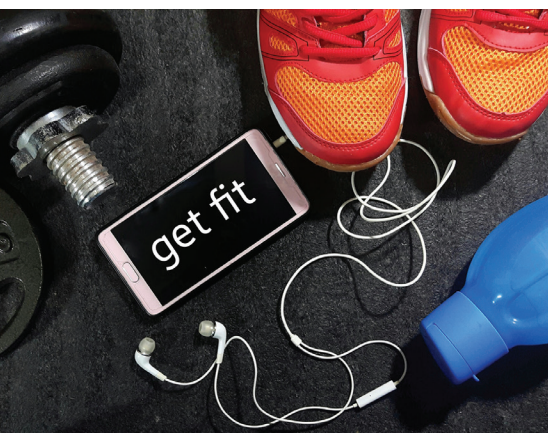

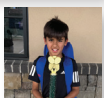

### Tennis Court Etiquette

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.

### Tennis Court Reminders

- Please remember all tennis court reservations are now available through the Riverstone app only.
- Remember that court reservations will be forfeited after 15 minutes of not showing up for scheduled start time.
- Tennis courts are for the use of tennis or pickleball play only. Any other sports or equipment are strictly prohibited. For more information refer to rule #4 at the Resource Center under Community Info.
- Parking for use of Tennis Courts 9 & 10 is at the Riverstone Blvd Recreation Center. Please refrain from parking within the Parkside neighborhood.

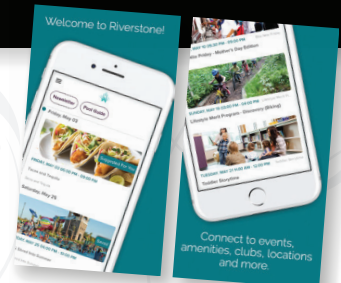
