RIVERSTONE HOA BOARD OF DIRECTORS CALL FOR CANDIDATES

The Riverstone Homeowners Association, Inc. is currently seeking individuals interested in running for the 2026 Board of Directors.

Below is a list of frequently asked questions regarding the Board and the election process:

Why is there an election for the Board? As stated in the community guidelines, elected Directors serve staggered terms based on the number of votes they receive. Paul Glass and Adi Talwar were assigned 1-year terms based on the results of the 2025 election. As a result, these two seats are open for candidate nominations for the 2026 Board of Directors.

What are the responsibilities of the Board? The primary role of the Board, with support from HOA staff, is to oversee the business of the association and plan for the future. This includes approving annual budgets, developing policies, adopting resolutions, awarding contracts for services, approving capital expenditures, hearing homeowners' appeals on deed restriction violation issues, making decisions on collection and legal matters, and guiding our staff. Board members are entrusted to make significant decisions that affect the community's well-being.

Do I have time for this? As a Board member, you will need to dedicate 15-20 hours per quarter to the Association (possibly more if you serve as an officer).

Who serves on the Board? The Riverstone HOA Board positions are held by Riverstone community residents in good standing.

How long is a Board member's term? Elected Board members will serve staggered terms. The positions open for election will serve a 3-year term beginning January 2026.

How are winners determined? A quorum of 10% of eligible members is required. Once this quorum is reached, the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes will serve 3-year terms.

Who tabulates the votes? A third-party company will handle the voting process and tabulate the results to ensure the integrity of the election. Neither the Riverstone HOA Board nor Management will be involved in verifying or tallying the votes.

Nomination forms will not be accepted after this time. FIREWORKS IN RIVERSTONE REMINDER

As the holiday season approaches, we encourage our residents to enjoy festivities in ways that align with the community's guidelines.

As a reminder to all residents, the use of fireworks in Riverstone is strictly prohibited under the HOA's deed restrictions. This includes all types of fireworks and applies to all areas within the neighborhood, including driveways, streets, and common areas. These restrictions are in place to preserve the quality of life for all homeowners by

minimizing loud disruptions, potential property damage, and negative impacts on pets and individuals sensitive to noise. Violations of the fireworks restriction may result in enforcement actions under the deed restrictions.

We appreciate everyone's cooperation in respecting our shared living environment and upholding the standards that keep our neighborhood enjoyable for all.

BUSINESS SPOTLIGHT

There's a new dog grooming service in town and it's already raising the "woof!"

BarkSuds brings a fresh approach to dog care with a focus on quality, love, and convenience. Whether your furry friend needs a quick bath or a full-on spa day, BarkSuds is ready to make tails wag all across Riverstone.

The business, owned by Dabrina and Nathan Hovanec, opened its doors in July. It stands out from the pack due to its focus on providing monthly membership pricing, quality grooming without the long wait, and ensuring that dogs feel safe and comfortable.

"What really makes BarkSuds special is how we treat every dog like our own," said Dabrina Hovanec. "No loud chaos, no stress — just a calm, caring environment where your dog gets one-on-one attention and lots of love."

Joining the BarkSuds family comes with "pawsome" perks. The Bath S'paw monthly membership fees are based on a dog's weight and range from \$45 for a small dog to \$89 for an extra-large pup.

The membership includes everything dogs need to stay clean, comfortable, and look great, including unlimited baths and brush-outs, nail trims, ear cleaning, gland expression, teeth brushing, deshedding, and more.

For dog parents who want a touch-up to the face, feet, and toosh (sanitary areas), BarkSuds offers an upgrade called the Dapper Dog. For dog parents who want a full groom, BarkSuds offers the All Over Rover. Like the Dapper Dog, owners can add this service anytime they feel it's needed for an additional charge and still bring in their pups for a weekly "s'paw" day.

Hovanec adds that regular grooming is about more than making your dog look good.

"Baths and brush-outs help prevent matting, skin issues and shedding, while nail trims protect joints and prevent painful overgrowth," she said. "Ear cleaning can stop infections before they start, and gland expression helps avoid discomfort."

Routine grooming also gives groomers a chance to spot any issues early, like bumps, skin irritations, or parasites. Plus, most dogs just feel better (and act happier) when they're clean, fresh, and tangle-free.

Appointments take an hour or less, which means fur babies are not left at the facility for half the day.



BarkSuds Sugar Land currently employs one groomer who is professionally trained, experienced, and incredibly passionate about making each dog look and feel their best, Hovanec said.

"She takes the time to get to know every pup's personality, coat type, and specific needs, so every groom is safe, gentle, and tailored to your dog," she said. "Having one groomer also means your dog will see a familiar face every visit—building trust, consistency, and a stress-free experience for both pets and their people."

Ensuring a stress-free visit is important to the Hovanecs.

"Our groomer and bathers work at your dog's pace, using positive reinforcement, soothing tones, and plenty of breaks when needed," Hovanec said. "We keep the environment quiet and low-key—no loud noises or crowded cages—so dogs feel safe and relaxed."

Dabrina Hovanec's desire to open a grooming business was born out of a love for animals.

"I wanted to create a space where pups are treated with kindness, patience, and love—and where pet parents feel confident leaving their fur babies in good hands. BarkSuds was born from that dream," she said.

She and her husband chose the Riverstone area because it already feels like home.

"The community here is so welcoming, family-oriented, and full of dog lovers who truly care for their pets," Hovanec said. "It's the kind of place where people support local businesses and where relationships matter. I wanted BarkSuds to be more than just a grooming spot, I wanted it to be part of the neighborhood."

Hovanec said that a dog's well-being is their top priority, and they love being able to provide affordable grooming so pups can stay clean and happy all year round.

"Whether your dog is a tiny pup or a big buddy, we're here to make grooming easy, stress-free, and enjoyable for everyone."

UNDERSTANDING NUTRITION LABELS

Understanding how to read nutrition labels is essential for making positive food choices, managing dietary preferences and ensuring that our food intake aligns with our health goals. Let's break down how to understand these labels and key factors to look for when choosing food options.

Serving Size. Look here for the serving size (the amount people typically eat at one time) and the number of servings in the package. Take note of your portion sizes and how much you are actually eating. If the serving size is one cup and you eat 2 cups, you are getting twice the calories, nutrients, and % daily value.

Calories. Calories provide a measure of how much energy you get from a serving of that food. To achieve or maintain a healthy body weight, balance the number of calories you eat and drink with the number of calories you have calculated according to your daily goals. Every individual's needs will vary.

Nutrients. This shows you key nutrients that impact your health. Look for foods that are high in the nutrients you need and low in the nutrients you want to limit. Pay attention to your macronutrients in this section: Aim for foods high in protein, moderate in carbs, and low in fats. Limit—Saturated Fat, Sodium, Added Sugars, Cholesterol and Trans Fat. Prioritize—Dietary Fiber, Protein, Vitamins and Minerals

Percent Daily Value. Percent Daily Value is for the entire day, not just one meal or snack. This number is the average level of nutrients based on a person who eats 2000 calories a day (this is the average set by the RDA, your needs may vary). Low is 5% or less—Aim low in Saturated Fat, Trans Fat, Cholesterol and Sodium. High is 20% or more—Aim high in Vitamins, Minerals, and Dietary Fiber.

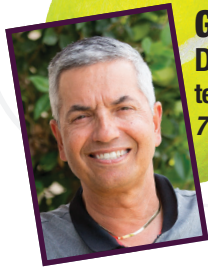

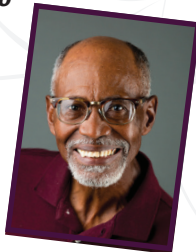

Tennis Court Etiquette

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.

Tennis Court Reminders

- Please remember all tennis court reservations are now available through the Riverstone app only.
- Remember that court reservations will be forfeited after 15 minutes of not showing up for scheduled start time.

ENRICHMENT–SAFETY

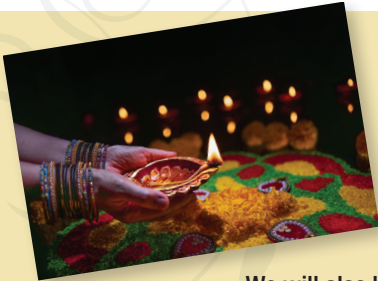
