## RIVERSTONE HOA BOARD OF DIRECTORS CALL FOR CANDIDATES

*The Riverstone Homeowners Association, Inc. is currently seeking individuals interested in running for the 2026 Board of Directors.*

Below is a list of frequently asked questions regarding the Board and the election process:

### ***Why is there an election for the Board?***

As stated in the community guidelines, elected Directors serve staggered terms based on the number of votes they receive. Paul Glass and Adi Talwar were assigned 1-year terms based on the results of the 2025 election. As a result, these two seats are open for candidate nominations for the 2026 Board of Directors.

### ***What are the responsibilities of the Board?***

The primary role of the Board, with support from HOA staff, is to oversee the business of the association and plan for the future. This includes approving annual budgets, developing policies, adopting resolutions, awarding contracts for services, approving capital expenditures, hearing homeowners' appeals on deed restriction violation issues, making decisions on collection and legal matters, and guiding our staff. Board members are entrusted to make significant decisions that affect the community's well-being.

### ***Do I have time for this?***

As a Board member, you will need to dedicate 10-12 hours per quarter to the Association (possibly more if you serve as an officer).

### ***Who serves on the Board?***

The Riverstone HOA Board positions are held by Riverstone community residents in good standing.

### ***How long is a Board member's term?***

Elected Board members will serve staggered terms. The positions open for election will serve a 3-year term beginning January 2026.

### ***How are winners determined?***

A quorum of 10% of eligible members is required. Once this quorum is reached, the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes will serve 3-year terms.

### ***Who tabulates the votes?***

A third-party company will handle the voting process and tabulate the results to ensure the integrity of the election. Neither the Riverstone HOA Board nor Management will be involved in verifying or tallying the votes.

## MOBILITY VS. FLEXIBILITY

***Though often used interchangeably, flexibility and mobility are entirely different concepts.***

***Flexibility***—The ability of muscles and connective tissue to lengthen passively, such as when performing a static stretch like touching your toes.

***Mobility***—The ability of a joint to actively move through its full range of motion. Good mobility requires flexibility, neuromuscular control, and free joint movement. Being flexible doesn't always mean you have good mobility.

### **Benefits of Both**

- **Better Performance**—Sports and activities like golf, soccer, and catching are easier with unrestricted joints and muscles.
- **Lower Injury Risk**—Strong, flexible muscles help prevent imbalances and injuries.
- **Less Pain in Daily Life**—Tasks like reaching, bending, or standing are easier when your body moves well.

### **Ways to Improve**

- Warm up with foam rolling and dynamic stretches.
- Join Riverstone's free Yoga class on Monday's at 6:00pm!
- Add mobility exercises to your warmup (leg swings, ankle circles, T-spine rotations).
- End workouts with static stretches (hamstrings, quads, upper back).

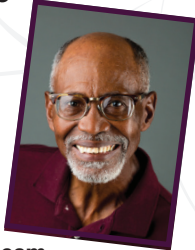

## Tennis Court Etiquette

- Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use so as not to disrupt players on adjacent courts.
- Never walk behind a court when a point is still in play. Wait until the point is over and then cross as fast as possible to get to your own court.
- When sending balls back to a neighboring court, roll them on to the back of the court.
- Never send them back while play is in progress. Also, if one of your balls rolls into an adjacent court, don't run after it, just wait for your neighboring court to return the ball when it's convenient.
- When reserving courts please be considerate to other residents by cancelling your reservation when you know that you will not be using it.

## Tennis Court Reminders

- Please remember all tennis court reservations are now available through the Riverstone app only.
- Remember that court reservations will be forfeited after 15 minutes of not showing up for scheduled start time.
- Tennis courts are for the use of tennis or pickleball play only. Any other sports or equipment are strictly prohibited. For more information refer to rule #4 at the Resource Center under Community Info.
- Parking for use of Tennis Courts 9 & 10 is at the Riverstone Blvd Recreation Center. Please refrain from parking within the Parkside neighborhood.



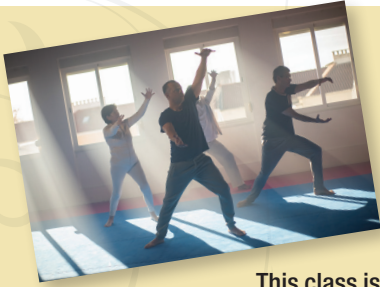

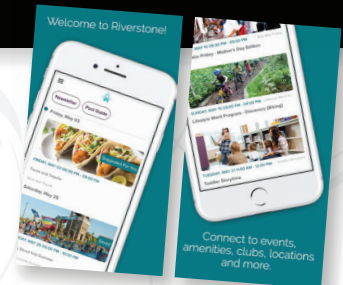
